


Site inspection Report

The Mining proposal of Mr. Manoj Kumar, S/o Late Shyam Prasad Yadav, Village – Chautha, Blocka and Thana – Rajauli, Nawada was inspected by the undersigned on 30/12/2016. The proposed sites viz. Pandana Forest and Mahuatad Forest are declared as notified Protected Forests vide Notification No. 5151 VIF/191/50R Dated 17/11/1950. The salient features of the site inspection report are as follows.

- i. The area of the Protected Forest proposed for diversion is Pandana PF, plot No. 57 is 1.6 acre and Mahuatad PF, plot No. 130 is 4.65, thus the total area is 6.25 acres. The present proposal for diversion is in continuity with the existing mining lease.
- ii. The area proposed for diversion is avoidable. The user agency has not proposed any alternative site explored earlier for mining purpose.
- iii. The site seems to be prone to soil erosion.
- iv. The site does not form part of a National Park, Wild life Sanctuary, Biosphere Reserve, Tiger Reserve and Elephant Corridor etc. The nearest wild life sanctuary is Gautam buddha Wildlife Sanctuary, Koderma, whose distance from work site is about 15 Km.
- v. No rare/ endangered/ unique species of flora or fauna are reported from this area.
- vii. No protected archeological / heritage / defense establishment or any other important monument was seen during the site inspection.
- viii. No tree is to be felled for mining.
