**Inspection Note of Chief Conservator of Forests (T.) Nashik.**

**Name of the Proposal :** Diversion of forest Land for construction of disaster Management works i.e. Sky walk , Bye pass road, Drainage Line & Sewage Treatment plant at Saptashruni Gad, Tal Kalwan , Dist Nashik. Area involved 0.8567 Ha.

Proposal for diversion of 0.8567 Ha. Forest land for construction of disaster Management works i.e. Sky walk , Bye pass road, Drainage Line & Sewage Treatment plant at Saptashruni Gad, Tal Kalwan , Dist Nashik has been received from Deputy Conservator of Forests , East Nashik division, Nashik

Site inspection of the above proposed land done by me on 22<sup>nd</sup> Jan. 2017 in presence of Deputy Conservator of Forests , East division, Nashik & Shri. K. R. Kedar, Deputy Executive Engineer , Tribal PWD, Sub division No.4 , Kalwan Camp, Nashik .

Proposal includes diversion of 0.1867 Ha. for Sky walk, 0.3329 Ha. for Bye pass road, 0.0837 Ha. for Drainage Line & 0.2534 Ha. for Sewage Treatment plant & other miscellaneous works. During site inspection it is found that the works of skywalk and by- pass road have been started in 2014 and now are in incomplete stage. The works were taken up much prior to submission of proposal for diversion under Forest Conservation Act 1980 which amount to violation of Forest Conservation Act 1980 & rules their in.

The proposal is site specific & very much needed to ease out the traffic and for crowd management at Saptashruni Gad during festival days . The Proposal is recommended to be sanctioned as there is no suitable alternative land available nearby subject to action to be taken on the responsible officers for violation of Forest Conservation Act 1980 under the Maharashtra Civil Services (Discipline & Conduct) Rules 1979.
