

SITE INSPECTION REPORT

(For the Forest land to be diverted under FCA)

Name of Project: - **Diversion of 6.35 Hectare Forest Land for 400 KV Ajmer (New)-Ajmer (RVPN) Power Transmission line for Power Grid Corporation of India Limited, Ajmer.**

A proposal has been received by this office from **Deputy Manager, P.G.C.I.L., Ajmer** for diversion (under FCA-1980) of **400 KV Ajmer (New)-Ajmer(RVPN) Power Transmission line for Power Grid Corporation of India Limited, Ajmer on Forest Land to be diverted 6.35 hectare** of forest land for non forestry purpose. The subject envisages the use of forest land for **400 KV Ajmer (New)-Ajmer(RVPN) Power Transmission line for Power Grid Corporation of India Limited, Ajmer on Forest Land to be diverted 6.35 hectare as described below-**

The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has been done by me on dated **30.01.2017** On inspection of the site, it is found that the land required by the user agency is a forest measuring **6.35 hectare Forest land used Forest Block Kanas Bansali (PF).**

The requirement of forest land as proposed by the user agency in Col.2 of Part-I is unavoidable and is barest minimum required for the project.
