Grantes, Chittoor for mining operations in compt. No.218 of Paradarani RF of Kammapalle Beat of Chittoor Section on 0.70.22.0217 along with the Forest Range Officer, Chittoor west Range, Chittoor, Dy. Range Officer, Chittoor and beat staff.

Initially the mining lease was sanctioned over an extent of 4.50 ha wide GO Ms.No. 51, EFSAT(Por-1) Dept., dz. 10.5.2007 and mining operators started from July 2007. Further as pre-related guidelines vide GOI MoRF, New Delhi F.No.8-25/2010-FC, dt.12.07.2012, the area of safety zone also included in the mining proposal and hence, the renewal proposals submitted by the UA for 5-43 Ha.

The user agency has demarcated applied mining area of 5.43 Ha for renaval (3.87 Ha for mining, 0.83 Ha for Sufety Zone 8.0.73 Ha for formation of Road). In the mining area of 3.97 Ha, 0.07 Ha is brively, and 6.694 Clum of mineral extracted up to December 2016. In the unbroken area, mineral is available and the user agency has applied for further reneval. The terrain consists of hilliock with big boudless and therrying youth allow the property of the property

The area is surrounded by scrub jurgle all around and there are no water bodies in the area. It is noticed that there are no historical, religious, archeological or recreational sites etc., in or close to the proposed mining area. The area does not fall in any Wild Life Sanchusry and National Park.

The total area sandtoned i.e., 4.90 Ha is utilized either for excavation for grantite or used for dumpting and as such no tree growth can be seen in this area except in area 0.53 Ho of safety zone, where the main tree species is Afbezzia amara and some Neem and under growth consists of Acadia cassia & some weeds and there no Wild falum is seen.
