Site inspection Report

Inspected the site for Electrification of Mokka ST Colony on 15.03.2017. The proposal is for diversion of 0.0385 ha of land for the electrification of Mokka ST colony in Anchal Range. No felling of trees is required for this diversion.

It is seen that the proposed work is for laying LT UG Cable for the total electrification of Mokka ST Colony in Kulathupuzha Grama Panchayath under total electrification scheme by Kerala Government. This diversion is essential for the electrification of the colony. The area does not have any rare / endangered / threatened species and not coming under protected area. The requirement of forest land as proposed by the user agency is unavoidable and bare minimum. No felling of trees is required for the diversion. During my inspection no work in violation of FC Act or guidelines is seen carried out by user agency. The project is recommended for approval.
