


SITE INSPECTION REPORT

Inspected the site on 16-03-2017. The proposal is for laying 110 m LT single phase 2 wire line and provide service connection to Smt. Baby under **Total electrification Scheme**. The forest area is Anjili plantation having middle aged trees and it is found that the area to be diverted for providing electric line is 0.022 ha. No trees are to be felled for drawing electric line at a width of 2 m through the forest area. No harm to forest, flora and fauna will be caused by the project. The area does not have rare / endangered / threatened species and is not part of protected area under Wildlife (Protection) Act 1972. No protected archaeological / heritage site / defence establishment is located in the area. The requirement of forest land as proposed by the user agency is unavoidable and bare minimum. During my inspection, no work in violation of the FC Act or guidelines is seen carried out by user agency. The project is recommended for approval.
