


Site inspection Report

I have personally verified the area proposed for laying the HT UG cable by the Kerala State Electricity Board Ltd on 23/01/2017 and also on 09/03/2017. This area falls in Shendurney Wildlife Sanctuary for about 1 Km in length. The cable will be laid on the existing road to Rosemala through the sanctuary at a distance of 1 Km and 0.35 metre width. No trees have to be felled or no damage to the existing forest will occur due to this project. This is the only means through which the people living in Rosemala enclosure will obtain electricity connection. No rare/ endangered/ unique species of flora and fauna are found in the proposed area. No protected archaeological / heritage site / defence establishment / any other important monument is located in the proposed area. The requirement of forest land as proposed by the user agency is 0.035 ha which is unavoidable and is the barest minimum for the project. The people living in Rosemala enclosure requires electricity for their day to day activities and for their betterment of their livelihood. The natives of Rosemala enclosure are very poor and definitely such a scheme will be highly beneficial for such people living inside this area for many years. A total of 400 families would get benefited out of this scheme. Hence, in these circumstances, for the betterment of the inhabitants of the enclosure, sanction for acceptance of the proposal may be given as per the existing laws.
