## SITE INSPECTION REPORT NOT BELOW THE RANK OF DCF (For the forest land to be diverted under FCA)

A proposal has been received by the Project Director, National Highway Athority of India, Project Implementation Unit Rae Bareilly for diversion (under FCA-1980) of 0.7954 ha. forest land for non forestry purpose. The project envisages the use of forest land for construction of byepass on NH -232 Km. 211.837 to Km. 222.868. The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has been done by me on dated.  $22 - \nu 3 - \frac{2017}{2}$ .

On inspection of the site, it was found that the required forest land as proposed by user agency is a unclassed forest measuring 0.7954 ha. The requirement of forest land proposed by the user agency in col.-2 part-1 is unavoidable and is barest minimum required for the project.
