11. Site inspection report of the DCF

The proposed retail outlet of BPCL lies in the side of the road plying from Dalsinghsarai to Vidyapatinagar. The proposed Forest area which is required to be used as entrance and out way as shown in the lay out map of BPCL is 0.0045 Ha. The proposed area is a part of P.F. (notification no.- 189E/190E dated – 16.02.1994). There is no tree present on the site. As per the observation made on the field and the facts stated above, the total land of the road side P.F. proposed for diversion for establishment of the Retail Outlet is 0.0045 ha.

There is no rare/ endangered/ unique species of flora & fauna found in the area, neither any archaeological site is present near the proposed site.
