
Inspection of proposed Mission Bhagiratha Pipeline Segment 24:

Tadlapet Range:

I have inspected the proposed pipe line area along with Forest Range Officer, Tadlapet and concerned staff, the entry and exists points along the main road are Lat: 19.087512, Long: 79.080271 and Lat: 19.0775483, Long: 79.0927801 respectively. The width of the proposed area is along the main road is 1 mtr. Further from point No. 595 (Lat: 19.087974 Long: 79.071905) to pipe line is passing upto Mallial village. The width in this passage is 0.70 mtrs.

Jannaram Range:

I have inspected the proposed pipe line area along with Forest Range Officer, Jannaram and concerned staff, the entry and exists points along the main road are Lat: 19.116737, Long: 79.0081096 and Lat: 19.0909066, Long: 79.0618855 respectively. The width of the proposed area is along the main road is 1 mtr. Further from point No. 592 (Lat: 19.0948202 Long: 79.0517075) the pipe line is passing upto Bommena village. The width in this passage is 0.70 mtrs. From the point No. 710 the pipe line is passing left side upto Alinagar Dongapalli and right side passing upto Bommena village. From point No. 568 (Lat: 19.1080075, Long: 79.0252952) the pipe is passing upto Kotha Puttiguda village.






Indanpalli Range:
