

SITE INSPECTION REPORT

Inspected the proposed site with the Deputy Conservator of Forests, Karwar Division, which is proposed for diversion of 0.304 Ha. of forest land in F.Sy.No. 44A of Baleguli village in Ankola Taluk for approach road to proposed stone crusher at Baleguli Bl.No. 1, 2A, 2B and 3 (Sy.No. 1/1, 1/2, 34, 1/3, 29/2) in favour of the Sri Narayan D. Nayak, M/s Shantika Crusher, Baleguli, Ankola Taluk, Uttar Kannada District

The proposed area having Mango Cashew, Neral Bamboo and Kindal trees and old kacha path. This path probably created during logging work long back, now not in use. In the proposed forest area there are specific fauna viz Panther is reported at the surrounding locality and unique species of flora are not found. No protected archaeological/heritage site/defence establishment or any other important is located in the area. There is no alternative land available for this purpose.

Hence I am recommending the proposed forest area for formation of approach road to proposed stone crusher in Baleguli private land and required forest area is minimum and essential which is only way to approach the proposed crusher site on recovery of Net Present Value, Compensatory Afforestation charges and by imposing usual conditions for a period of 20 years as requested by user agency.
