

Site Inspection Report of Forest land proposed to be diverted under FCA

Name of the proposal:- Village Relocation from Mukundra Tiger Reserve

The site was inspected by me with DCF Kota Sh. Lalit Singh Ranawat and user agency officials DCF-II MNP Kota, Sh. T. Mohan Raj, Acf MNP Sh. Deepak Kumar , RO Relocation kota Sh. Rajendra Meghwal, Surveyor MNP Kota Sh. Mahesh Burdak on 18-08-2017

The user agency has applied for 100 ha. area to relocate two villages as per recommendation of district level relocation committee meeting minutes of 12-7-2016. The proposed area falls in Lakhava 'B' reserve forest block of kota division in kota district. This forest area is in urban limits of kota city. Area is devoid of trees with sparse growth of shrubs of Cassia tora, Prosopis juliflora, Dichrostachys cineria, Zizyphus species etc. There is very little soil cover over the rocky bottom and at many places rocks are visible on the surface itself. Area is undulating and susceptible to very weak erosion.

The requirement is unavoidable and barest minimum. There is no rare endangered/unique species of flora & fauna found in this area. There is no protected archeological/heritage site/defence establishment or any other important monument in this area. No violation has been done.

The proposal is recommended for acceptance in the larger interest of Wild life of Mukundra Tiger Reserve Kota.
