

Filed inspection notes of Sri D.Chandrasekhar Rao, SFS., Divisional Forest Officer,  
Kurnool Division, Kurnool in Dhone Range on 21.07.2017.

Inspected the forest land proposed for diversion of 0.12 Ha of forest land for laying of Optical Fiber Cable (OFC) along the road within the existing Right of Way passing through Compt.No.226 (length-0.72 Km- extent 0.03 Ha) 219 (Length-1.57 Km, extent-0.06 Ha) & 220 (Length- 0.64 Km, extent -0.027 Ha), Jaladurgalm R.F of Dhone Range of Kurnool Division in Kurnool district falls within jurisdiction of Kommemarri village in Peapully tehsils along with Forest Range Officer, Dhone and concerned staff on 21.07.2017.

Further regeneration of following species are found in the proposed area i.e., *Hardwickia binnata*, *Soyamide Febrifuge*, *Anogeissus latifolia*, *Gorivi*, *Dolichandrone Crispa*, *Carissa carandas* etc. in Compt.No.219, 220 & 226, Jaladurgam Reserved Forest, Jaladurgam Beat, Racherla Section of Dhone Range and the density of the proposed area is 0.1 under Eco-class-III open forest.

The area proposed diversion of forest land not form the part of National Park, Wildlife Sanctuary and there are no Elephant corridors and does not consists of any Archeological & Monumental structures. Further there are no endangered forest species in the proposed area.

Further, the user agency has not necessary to identify the Compensatory Afforestation area as per para-3.2-viii-No Compensatory afforestation shall be insisted upon in respect of proposals involving diversion of forest land upto **one Hector**.
