

**ITE INSPECTION REPORT AS PER SL. NO. 11 HIGHLIGHTING FACTS AS
ASKED IN SL. NO. 7 (xi, xii), 8 and 9 of PART- II.**



The mahal site of Jagiroad Stone Mahal No. F (1) within Sonaikuchi R. F. has been inspected by me on 20/5/2017 and report thereof furnished as under :

During my inspection, no any rare/endangered/unique species of flora and fauna are found in the area. Further, no archeological/heritage site/defence establishment or any other important monument is located in the area.

Total area of Nagaon District is 3831 Sq. KM. and Morigaon District is 1704 Sq. KM. heaving a combine population of both Districts is 32,72,482 Nos. Both the Districts are very backward in infrastructure Development and huge developmental thrust is required. The major work completed under Morigaon District is the 4 laning works of NH- 37 and the same is partly competed under Nagaon District. The immediate proposed and pending works of developmental concern under the Division are-

1. State Highway No. 3, 715A.
2. Nagaon Medical College.
3. Nagaon Engineering College.
4. Bridge over Brahmaputra at Kalia- Bhumura.
5. PMGSY, MGNREGA, Zilla Parisad works related to road construction.
6. River protection work under Water Resources Departments, etc.

In addition to the above, to meet the local demand for Stone/Boulder & GSB it is pertinent that the Mahal/MMC Area needs immediate opening for mining.

Further, there is no violation of the Forest Conservation Act, 1980, reported as on date.
