

Site Inspection Report not Below the Rank of DCF (For the Forest Land to be Diverted under FCA)

A proposal has been received by this office from National Highway Authority of India for diversion under (FCA-1980) of 97.896 Ha of forest land for non forestry purpose. The project envisages the use of forest land for " Four lane Widening Construction of Aligarh to Kanpur (NH- 91) road Km 229.00 to 289.00 (Kalyanpur to Naviganj) Total Length 60 km. in Mainpuri District " The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has done by me on dated - 19/9/2017

On inspecting on the site, it is found that the land required by the user agency is a protected forest measuring 97.896 Ha.

The requirement of forest land as proposed by the user agency in col 2 part-1 is unavoidable and is barest minimum required for the project.
