

Field Inspection Note of Sri. Ch. Ganga Reddy, S.F.S.,
District Forest Officer, Mahabubnagar on 12/09/2017 at Kondapur Forest Block in
Compt.No.187 & 189 of Kondapur Section of Mohammadbad Range of
Mahabubnagar District.


On 12/09/2017 proceeded and inspected the area proposed for diversion of 0.0775 Ha of Forest-Land in **Compt. No. 187 & 189 of Kondapur Forest Block area** of Kondapur Section of Mohammadabad Range, Mahabubnagar Forest Division for **laying of Optical Fibre Cable along the road** and within the existing Right of way in favour of **M/s. Bharat Broad Band Network Limited** is transacted and observed that:

The total Forest Area in **Compt.No.187 of Kondapur Reserve Forest** is **196.260 Ha** & **Compt.No.189 of Kondapur Reserve Forest** is **141.390 Ha**. The Forest Area of this Compartments Area is degraded area and having only bushy left over of old miscellaneous growth. The canopy density is about 0.20. There are no Trees falling in the proposed area for **laying of Optical Fibre Cable along the road**, in the proposed area in Kondapur Reserve Forest. There are no rare / endangered / unique species of flora and fauna in this proposed area and also there are no protected archaeological / heritage site/defence establishment.

The degraded Forest area diverted for this purpose is only 0.0775 Ha. The area proposed for **laying of Optical Fibre Cable along the road** Passing through the Kondapur section of Reserve Forest Kondapur at Mohammadabad Range in Mahabubnagar District, in favour of **M/s. Bharat Broad Band Network Limited** also provides internet connectivity from Villages to Mandals, and Mandals to District Head Quarters.

There are no rare / endangered / unique species of flora and fauna in this proposed area and also there are no protected archaeological / heritage site/defence establishment. Etc.,

Hence, it is recommended to divert the Forest Area.
