

Site Inspection Report

The proposed area of 1.75 Ha in Karivanahatti Kaval State Forest is inspected by me on 28.12.2017. This diversion of forest area is for construction of 765 KV S/C Transmission line from Dharmapuri to Madugiri (Tumkur) of POWERGRID NM Transmission Ltd. The area falls in Sy No 1, Karivanahatti Kaval Village, Kanakapura Range, Ramanagara Division. It was observed that

1. The area is devoid^{of} any rare/endangered / unique species of flora and fauna and is not prone to soil erosion.
2. The density of vegetation is of Eco Class 4 (dry forest).
3. The forest land as proposed by the user agency is unavoidable and bare minimum for the project.
4. The reserve forest is not a part of any protected area/ sanctuary /National Park/ eco sensitive zone.
5. There are no historical & archeological monuments in the proposed area.

The User agency should protect the land from encroachment, illegal felling and forest fire. With this condition the area proposed for diversion is recommended for approval since the requirement of area is un- avoidable, bare minimum and the proposal is in the general public interest and helps in improvement of socio- economic status of the local people.
