(For the Forest Land to be diverted under FCA)

A proposal has been received by this office from Narmada Forest Division, Rajpipla for diversion (under FCA) of 64 ha. of forest land for forestry and non-forestry purpose. The project envisages the use of forest land for Tiger Safari Park. The site inspection of the land involved in the proposed has been done by me Dt. 18/01/2018

On inspection of the site it is found that the land required by the user agency as reserved forest admeasuring 64 ha.

The requirement of forest land as proposed by the agency in Col.2 of part-I is unavoidable and barest minimum for the project.

No protected archaeological / heritage site / defense establishment or any other important monuments is located in the area.


No rare / endangered / unique species of flora and fauna found in the area.
