

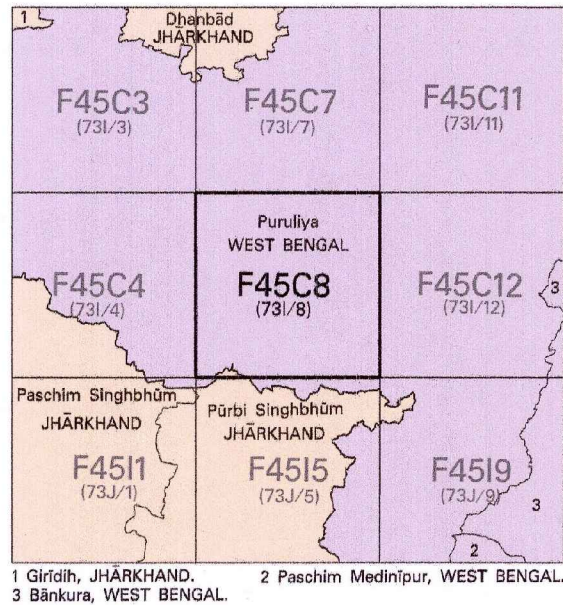

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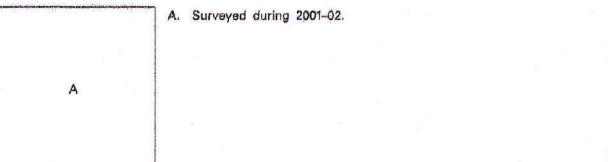

Unmetalled roads in this sheet are generally passable in dry season.
A water height, e.g., represents the approximate height in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.
The state boundary between Jharkhand (former Bihar) and West Bengal State has been surveyed as per the order of the Government of India on the ground but has not been verified by the Government of Jharkhand.
