NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 3A of the Arunachal Pradesh Village Forest Reserve (Constitution and Maintenance) Act, 1975 (Act No. 1 of 1976), as amended in 1984 read with section 4 & 5 of the Assam Forest Regulation, 1891 (7 of 1891), the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh proposes to constitute the land described in the Schedule hereunder as Village Forest Reserve (VFR).

North	Starting from a point at Taji-Tara Gyapin ridge at geo-coordinates 27° 14' 59.434" N and 93° 19' 24.872" E, the boundary moves east wards at bearing 94° upto the point at geo-coordinates 27° 14' 58.106" N and 93° 19' 49.371" E. Thence, at bearing 75° for about 390.0 mtr. upto the point at geo-coordinates 27° 15' 1.332" N and 93° 20' 1.508" E. Thence, at bearing 88° till it meet Longryap nalla. Thence, along the right bank of the nalla down stream till it meets Par river at geo-coordinates 27° 15' 3.112" N and 93° 20' 15.143" E.	
East	Thence, down stream along the right bank of Par river passing through the points at geo-coordinates 27° 14' 57.065" N and 93° 20' 19.076" E, 27° 14' 52.774" N and 93° 20' 27.747" E, 27° 14' 30.211" N and 93° 20' 29.906" E, 27° 14' 27.469" N and 93° 20' 38.070" E upto the point where it meet an unnamed nalla at geo-coordinates 27° 14' 24.022" N and 93° 20' 38.520" E.	
South	Thence, upstream along the nalla upto its source at geo-coordinates 27° 14' 17.370" N and 93° 20' 19.282" E, thence, at bearing 250° for about 648 mtr. upto the point at geo-coordinates 27° 14' 10.022" N and 93° 19' 59.659" E. Thence, at bearing 271° for about 756 mtr. upto the point at geo-coordinates 27° 14' 10.130" N and 93° 19' 35.179" E.	
West	Thence, at bearing 304° for about 336 mtr. upto the point at geo-coordinates 27° 14' 16.234" N and 93° 19' 26.086" E, thence, at bearing 339° for about 294.0 mtr. upto the point at geo-coordinates 27° 14' 24.932" N & 93° 19' 22.623" E, thence, at bearing 26° for about 227 mtr. upto the point at geo-coordinates 27° 14' 31.527" N and 93° 19' 25.666" E, thence, at bearing 335° for about 357 mtr. upto point at geo-coordinates 27° 14' 41.837" N and 93° 19' 20.594" E. Thence, at 25° for about 192.0 mtr. upto source of an unnamed nalla, thence, down stream along the nalla upto the starting point at geo-coordinates 27° 14' 59.434" N and 93° 19' 24.872" E.

Further more, the Governor is also pleased to appoint the Divisional Forest Officer, Sagalee Forest Division, to be the Forest Officer under sub-section (2) of section 5 of the said Regulation who shall assist the Forest Settlement Officer in the inquiry prescribed in Chapter II of the Assam Forest Regulation, 1891.

The Governor of Arunachal Pradesh is further pleased to appoint the Secretary (GA), Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh to hear the appeals under section 15 of the said regulation.
