- e. Set fire to grass, trees, timber or kindle a fire on the land.
- f. Hunt, shoot, fishing, poison water and set traps on the said land.

2. The income from compounding of offences against the rules under Section 68 of the Indian Forest Act, 1927, shall be credited to the State Government.
