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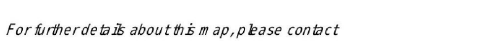

Heights are in metres and above Indian mean sea level.
 Contours are approximate.
 A relative height of 37.20 represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.
 A streamer shows its main alignment along the Godavari River between Venkatapuram and Rajmahmud from July to February.
 All track roads are jeppable and unsealed roads motorable in dry season.
 Tanks, shown in this area usually contain water from July to December.
 The district boundary in the Godavari follows the mean deep water channel and will be surveyed with the fluctuations of that channel.
 The State boundary between Andhra Pradesh and Chhattisgarh States has been changed as pointed out by the local officials on this map, but has not been verified by the Governments concerned.
 The major station on the Godavari is Rajamahmud. The Andhra Pradesh State are called "Mandali" and boundaries are shown by thick boundary symbol.
 Gopuram is shown thus
 The administrative boundaries are shown as dotted but have been surveyed as pointed out by the local officials on this map and have not been verified by the authorities concerned.
