With reference to the letter cited above, it is to inform you that, the Site Specific Wildlife Conservation Plan has been approved separately by the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests(Wildlife) & Chief Wildlife Warden, Odisha, Bhubaneswar, for dip side Manoharpur Coal Mine with total financial intervention of **Rs. 847. 307/- lakhs** (Sundargarh-760.307/- lakhs & Jharsuguda-87/-lakhs) vide letter under reference.

Hence, there is no need to revision in Site Specific Wildlife Conservation Plan cost based on increased wage rate, as the above Site Specific Wildlife Conservation Plan for Dip Side Manoharpur Coal Mine of OCPL.




