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It is informed that wherein the Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests, (HoFF), Andhra Pradesh, Guntur has communicated the Stage-I approval under Section- 2 of Forest Conservation Act,1980 for Diversion of 1.79 Ha of Forest Land in Compt.No.467, Sandrakonda RF, Kanigiri Range of Giddalur Division for Upgradation of NH-167B from Km.86/540 to Km.87/340 i.e., Porumamilla to Chandrasekharapuram to two lanes with paved shoulders under NHDP-IV in the State of Andhra Pradesh in favour of Executive Engineer (R&B) NH Division, Kadapa subject to the fulfillment of the conditions laid down in the G.O.Ms.No.133, EFS&T (Section-II), Dept. Dt.30.11.2018 of Andhra Pradesh.

As per the instructions in the reference 5<sup>th</sup> the cited above, the Executive Engineer (R&B) NH Division, Kadapa is hereby requested to pay the following amounts.

- I. Amount demanded to be deposited in Adhoc CAMPA, Corporation Bank, Lodhi Road, New Delhi through e-challan only. (As per IGF, Ad-hoc, CAMPA Lr.No.12-2/2010-CAMPA, Dt.09.06.2016 communicated vide PCCFs, Rc.No.45921/2001/FCA-4(i), Dt.04.07.2016.)**

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- The user agency has furnished undertakings for payment of NPV, Addl. NPV, CA, Trees extraction charges etc.

**I (a) Procedure for e-challan generation:**

1. On issue of this demand notice, the user agency shall log into Forest Clearance portal and the User agency should pay through e-payment mode i.e. challan generated through the Ministry's website portal (i.e. [www.forestclearance.nic.in](http://www.forestclearance.nic.in)) to generate e-challan and make payment against the demand.
2. The user agency shall fill all the details as per the format provided in the portal and submit to Nodal Officer for verification.
3. Once it is verified by the Nodal Officer, the user agency can generate e-challan from the portal.

**I (b) Procedure payment through RTGS:**

1. For payment through RTGS, the representative of the user agency should visit his bank branch (RTGS enabled) of a Bank of his choice along with printed e-challan with an Account Number printed on it.
2. While tendering the e-challan at the bank, the user agency must ensure that the unique account number mentioned in the challan should be correctly mentioned as the account number in which funds to be remitted.
3. Upon executing the RTGS by the sender/remitter bank, the amount collected will be credited to relevant CAMPA State Account with the Bank on real time basis.

Further, it is informed that the user agency should comply with the following in accordance with the Govt. of India instructions issued cited F.No.7-23/2012-FC, Dt.24.07.2013 and publish the orders at the cost of the project proponent.

1. Publish the entire forest clearances granted in verbatim along with the conditions and safe- guards imposed by the Central Government in two widely circulated daily newspapers, one in vernacular language and an other in English language, so as to make people aware of the permission granted to the project proponent for use of forest land for non- forestry purposes.
2. The copies of the Forest Clearance should also be submitted to the Heads of local bodies, Panchayats and Municipal Bodies by the project proponents in addition to the relevant offices of the Government who in turn has to display the same in 30 days.

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It is also requested to the Executive Engineer (R&B), NH Division, Kadapa to submit the compliance report as per the conditions stipulated in the reference 4<sup>th</sup> cited with relevant proofs/ under takings for onward submission to the Prl.Chief Conservator of Forests, (HoFF), A.P., Guntur through Conservator of Forests, Guntur Circle, Guntur for further necessary action and for obtaining the final approval.
