**DEMAND NOTICE**

It is Submitted that the Government of Telangana vide ref 5th cited has issued Principle (Stage-I) approval for diversion of 0.4768 Ha of Forest land in Narsampet Range in Warangal Rural District for laying of optical fiber cable in favour of M/s Telangana Fiber Grid Corporation Limited Hyderabad and the same is communicated by the vide reference 6<sup>th</sup> cited by the Principal Chief Conservator of Forest (HOFF) Telangana and instructed to raise the Demand Notice over the user agency for making payment of compensatory levies; obtain the compliance report from the user agency and furnish through CCF Warangal for obtaining stage-II final approval.
2. Accordingly the following compensatory Levies are prepared.
  - (i) Cost of MPV Rates are calculated shown as below Column No.3(iii)

1.	The Eco- Class of proposed forest for diversion is Eco-Class III i.e., consisting of Tropical Dry Deciduous Forests with a density of 0.1 to 0.4 (Open Forest) and as per the revised NPV rates the cost of NPV is 0.4768 Ha *Rs:957780/Ha= Rs: 456670/-		
2	As per the revised NPV rates for Eco value class the rate per Ha of open forest of Eco value class III is Rs: 957780/- per Ha. And 5 times as the area is falling in Pakhal Wild life Sanctuary.		
3	The value of NPV is the product of area proposed for diversion of forest and rate per Ha.	0.4768 Ha X Rs:957780/Ha X 5	Rs: 22,83,350/-

As per the revised NPV calculations the amount to be deposited by the user agency is Rs: 456670/- The user agency should compulsorily deposit the NPV amount by generating challan

through the Ministry's website. The user agency will be directed to submit the compensatory levies towards CA, NPV e.t.c; into the Telangana stage Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority (CAMPA). Saving Bank account maintained in the Corporation Bank, CGO Complex, Lodhi Road, New Delhi- 110003 (RTGS/ IFSC No. CORP0000371. Through online mode only, through e-portal method at MoEF & CC, GOI New Delhi portal i.e; <http://parivesh.nic.in> by generating the challan in consultation with Nodal Officer Telangana State Forest Department. The user agency needs to upload the Demand Notice against the Project for approval by Nodal Officer (FCA), Telangana and generate challan after approval. The payment to made against the challan No. And the challan is valid for one week. A Step by step process is available at <http://parivesh.nic.in>

ii) Further it is submitted that, as per the circular instructions vide PCCF, TS HYD Rc.No. 03/2015/FCA-1, dt.13.09.2017, Manual digging of trench without any machine involvement wherever tree growth is there for 10595 mts have been calculated and the charges has to be paid by the user agency in **District Forest Officer, Warangal Rural, A/c. No. 39123522963,SBI, Nakkalagutta, IFSC: SBHY0020150**. The details of demand notice is as shown below.

3. Further, the User Agency has to comply with following in accordance with the MoEF&CC, GoI instructions issued vide F.no.7-23-2012-FC, Dt.24.07.2013 communicated vide Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests, A.P. Hyderabad Rc.No.45921/2001/F4, Dt.23.08.2013:

- a) Publish the entire forest clearances granted in verbatim along with the condition and safeguards imposed by the Central government in two widely circulated daily newspaper one in vernacular language and the other in English granted to the project proponent for the use of forest land for the non-forest purposes.
- b) The copies of the forest clearance should also be submitted to the heads of local bodies, Panchayats and municipal bodies by the project proponents in addition to the relevant offices of the Government who in turn has to display the same for 30 days.
4. Further, the User Agency has to furnish the compliance on the conditions stipulated in the Stage- I approval for onward submission to Government for obtaining Stage-II approval.
5. The transfer of forest land to User Agency shall not be affected prior to the issue of final (Stage II) approval or working permission.

As per the instructions issued by the Principal Chief Conservator of Forest (FCA) Telangana Hyderabad and CCF Warangal draft demand notice is issued to the user agency for vetting.
