Wooded areas are coloured green. Scattered trees and other vegetation are in green, but prominent surveyed trees are in black.

Cart-tracks in this sheet, against which there is no descriptive remark, are generally motorable (four-wheel drive) in dry season.
Tracks, shown dry, in this area usually contain water from July to December.
In areas where no tube-wells exist, cultivation is periodic and dependent on rainfall.
