Heights are in metres and above India mean sea level $\pm$.

Contours are approximated.

Ticks shown only in the area, usually contain water from July to March.

Wells are numerous in square C (7, 7) and only the Imperial ones have been shown.

Cast roads and unimproved roads: in this area, are generally metalled in dry season. Permission to use these trade route lanes is required from the Forest Authorities.

A relative height, Δh represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.

The kilometre scale variables along roads are shown in short type e.g. $\frac{1}{2}$ whereas milestone numbers, are shown in upright type e.g. $\frac{1}{2}$.

The common boundary between the Protected Forests are not shown, for want of reliable information.

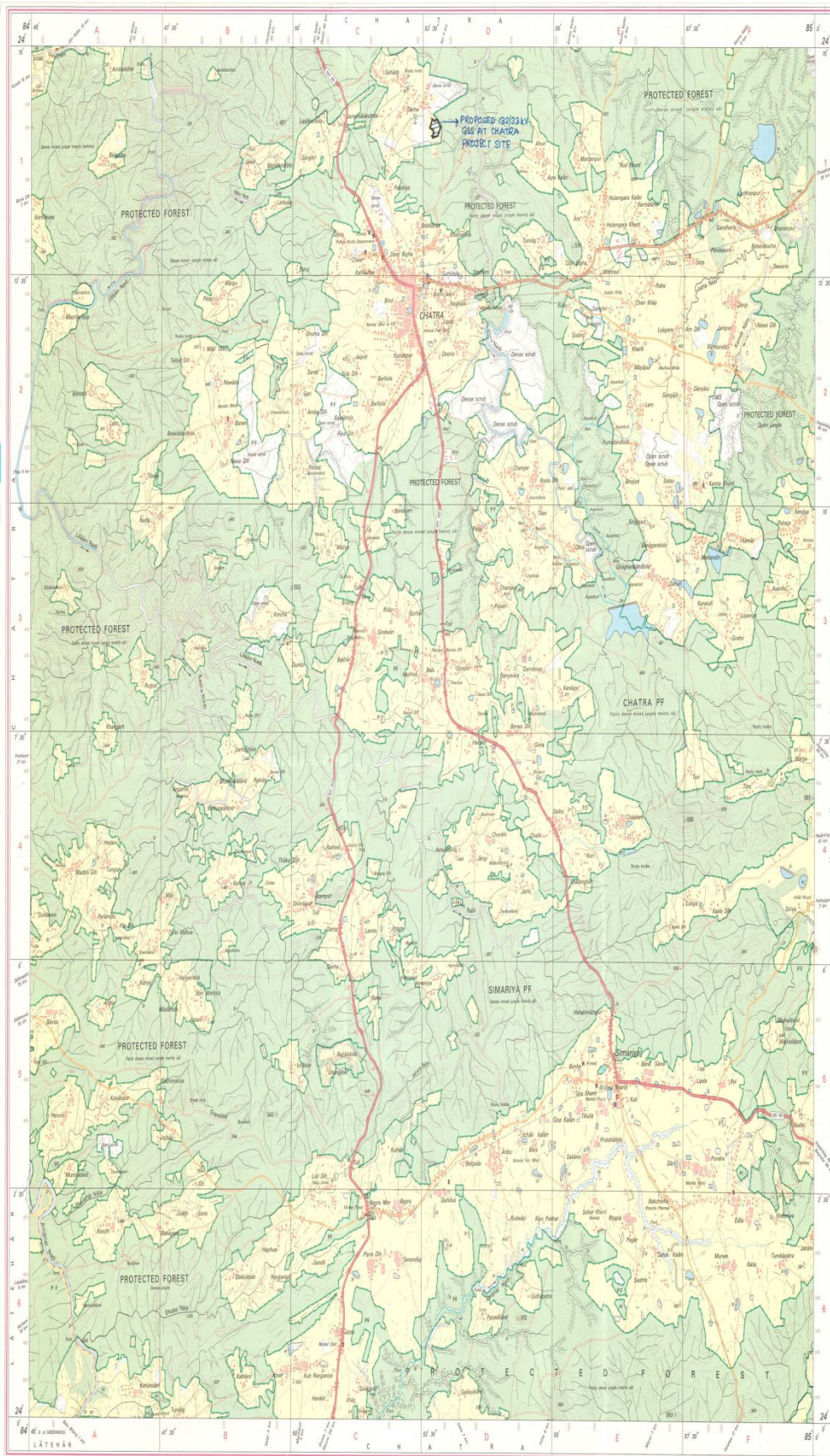
