Compensatory Afforestation Schemes for the treatment of the non-forest land handed over by TSGENCO in lieu of the forest area diverted for the establishment of Thermal Power Station

In the light of the provisions contained under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980, it is mandatory to take up treatment practices for development of the non-forest land handed over in lieu of forest area diverted for non-forestry purposes. The total forest land proposed for diversion in lieu of the establishment of Thermal Power Station (4400MW & 2400MW) in Nalgonda district in favour of TSGENCO is 4034.01ha (2389.72ha in Veerlapalem RF, 1076.42ha in Chikarapur RF, 284.37ha in Gangadevi Gattu RF) of Nalgonda Territorial Division.

AREA:-

In lieu of the proposed diversion of the above forest lands, non forest land for C.A land to an extent of 14864.23 Acres was identified by the User Agency in (71) locations spread over entire district. The areas have been inspected initially by the Forest department and given suitability to an extent of 10716.00 acres / 4336.70 Ha. However due to presence of the street rock which cannot be excluded, the entire area of 14864.23 acres has to be handed over to the forest department by the user agency. The non-forest land identified by the User agency i.e., TSGENCO, which falls in Nalgonda (N) and Nagarjunasagar (WLM) divisions. The entire area is located in 5 Revenue Divisions (Devarakonda, Nalgonda, Miryalaguda, Suryapet and Bhongir) and 16 Mandalas (Chandamper, Gundlapally, Marriguda, Nampally, Narayanpur, Pettakonda, Matamandali, Miryalaguda, Jajireddy Gudem, Nadigudem, Penupat, Thirumagan, Ahmakur (S), Suryapet, Bhongir, Rajapet, Thurikapally and Waragin Guttal) of Nalgonda district. The details of the CA areas handed over is furnished hereunder:

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As the area proposed for CA by the User agency is spread over the entire district and is under the jurisdiction of Nalgonda (T) and Nagarjunasagar (WLM) divisions, combined CA scheme is prepared for the areas of Nalgonda (T) and Nagarjunasagar (WLM) divisions in the 4336.7ha. area over a period of 10 years ie., from 2015-16 to 2024-25, as per the current wage rate (FSR of 2014-15) of Zone III. As most of the CA areas handed over are hillocks, portions of which are covered with sheet rock, boulders and granite, main emphasis will be on the overall development of the area by providing protection and aiding natural regeneration by adopting treatment practices based on site-specific, edaphic and climatic conditions of the area. The following are the treatment practices proposed to be taken up:

OBJECTIVE:-

The main objective of the scheme is to compensate for the loss due to the diversion of forest land by development of the non-forest land handed over by the User Agency, utilizing the funds of the concerned user agency. Implementing agency will be Telangana State Forest Department. The treatment practices adopted in the present scheme over 4336.7ha. acquired area and the techniques proposed to be followed are briefly discussed below:

I. Raising of Plantations (Rs. 1012.06lakhs)

Considerable area of the non-forest land proposed to be handed over in lieu of the forest area diverted comprises of sheet rock, boulders and granite. Most of these areas are classified as "Guttalu/Hillocks/Bancharayi" as per revenue records. Portions of these areas are covered with vegetation, while the remaining areas consist of sheet rock/boulders/granite. Only the areas covered with vegetation excluding the sheet rock portion are suitable for compensatory afforestation and as such these areas mostly require protection rather than the need to be afforested by taking up plantation. As it is not possible to take up semi-mechanical plantations on a large scale, it is proposed to take up gap planting @ 200seedlings/ha based on soil and other local conditions of the area. ANR cum BHA model will be followed. The species proposed to be planted are Marri, Juvvi, Narayepi, Nemalinara, Vepa, Tellamaddi, Chintha, Rela, Seemaruba, Kanuga, Nallamaddi and other misc. species.

II. Maintenance of Plantations (Rs. 944.230 lakhs)

The seedlings planted in gaps will be maintained for a period of 8 years ie., upto 2017-2018 to 2024-25. Casualty replacement upto 20% will be taken up during 1st year maintenance. Operations like replacement of casualties, application of fertilizers, circular weeding cum deep soil working will be taken up under maintenance.

III. Establishment of Central Nurseries (Rs. 200lakhs)

Tall seedlings of various species will be needed for gap planting. As there is no proper infrastructure to cater to this requirement, it is proposed to establish central nurseries at various locations covering both Nalgonda (T) and Nagarjunasagar

(WLM) divisions. These nurseries will be utilized for raising and maintenance of the seedlings till they are out planted in the field.

IV. Improvement of Natural Forests (Rs. 216.835 lakhs)

Since there is limited scope for planting, enrichment of the CA areas is proposed to be taken over the entire area by taking up operations viz., coppice cutting, pruning, singling, removal of unwanted growth etc.

V. Soil and Moisture Conservation Works (Rs. 216.835 lakhs)

To enable soil and moisture conservation, SMC works viz., Construction of RCC Check Dams/Rock Fill Dams across nallahs and vagus; Digging of Contour trenches, Mini Percolation tanks are proposed to be taken up.

VI. Forest Protection (Rs. 12811.106 lakhs)

As multi-dimensional works are being proposed in the area, it is essential to safeguard the area. Hence chain link fencing and construction of boundary pillars will be taken up all over the area for protection from biotic pressure and demarcation of the area. The area is proposed to be protected further by engaging watch & ward and striking forces in addition to the regular forest staff. Other protection measures viz., procurement of patrolling vehicles, wireless communication facility, digitization of forest blocks & publicity and extension are proposed to be taken up for safeguarding the areas completely.

VII. Forest Fire Management (Rs. 351.388 lakhs)

Fire tracing operations are proposed to be taken up in the area by taking up creation and maintenance of firelines, employing fire watchers etc. for safeguarding the areas against fire.

VIII. Infrastructure Development (Rs. 315 lakhs)

Infrastructure development activities are proposed to be taken up with a financial outlay of Rs. 315 lakhs.

In addition, Administrative Costs @ 10% with a financial outlay of Rs. 315.00 lakhs is proposed for administrative and other miscellaneous costs involved in smooth conduct of the scheme.

AGENCY RESPONSIBLE:-

The Forest Department will be responsible for implementing the Compensatory Afforestation Scheme with the funds deposited by the User Agency.

PROJECT PERIOD:-

It is proposed to implement the scheme for a period of 10 years ie., from 2015-16 to 2024-25.

FUNDING AGENCY:-

The total financial outlay will be met by the user agency i.e. TSGENCO..

EXECUTIVE AGENCY:-

The Divisional Forest Officers, Nalgonda (T) and Nagarjunasagar (Wildlife Management) will be the implementing agency for this scheme for 3268.05 ha and 1065.96ha respectively.
