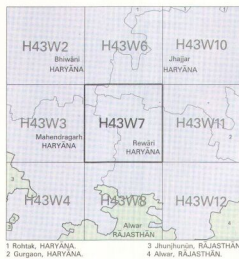

- Contours are approximate
- A relative height e.g., 40, marked along a canal, indicates the height of the top of the canal embankment, measured from the adjacent country
- Tanks shown only in this area usually contain water from July to December
- Tide marks are indicated throughout the sheet, only the high tide mark has been shown
- Unmetalled roads and cart tracks in this sheet are generally metalled in dry season. Permission to use these along canals is required from the irrigation authorities
- Canal distance shown along the canal is 500 feet apart and every existing 1000 feet shown in sheet and on other canals there are 1000 feet apart and every existing 1000 feet shown in sheet
