**NOTES**

Heights are in metres and above Indian mean sea level.

Tanks, shown dry in this area, usually contain water from July to December.

A relative height,  $\Delta$ , represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.

Wells and tube-wells are numerous throughout the State, only the important ones have been shown.

All castles along canals and unmetalled roads in this area are generally metalled in dry season whereas other cart-roads against which there is no descriptive remark are passable in dry season.

Permission to use these along canals is required from irrigation authorities.

The district one tenth boundaries when following the main deep water channel of the Gomati River, will change with the fluctuations of that channel.

The kilometre stone numbers along the railways, roads and canals are shown in short type, e.g., '5' whereas milestone numbers are shown in upright type, e.g., '5'.
