In Compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forest (MOEF) Govt. of India letter no. 11- 9/98- FC (pt), dated 3rd August 2009 were in the MOEF issued guidelines on submission of evidence for having initiated and completed the process of settlements of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights Act) 2006 (FRA for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes, it is certified that **0.06 Acre. of Forest Land** proposed to be diverted in favour of **Village Chungru Harhi Nala Bridge Construction** in Latehar District falls within jurisdiction of **Chungru** village in Barwadih Tehsil.

It is further certified that,

- a) The complete process for identification and settlement of rights under the FRA has been carried out for the entire **0.06 Acre. of Forest Land** area proposed for diversion. A copy of records of all consultations and meetings for the Forest Rights Committee(s). Gram Sabha(s). Sub Divisional Level Committee(s) and the District Level Committee are enclosed as annexure to annexure
- b) The proposal for such diversion (with full details of the project and its implications, in vernacular/ local language) have been placed before each concerned Gram Sabha of forest-dwellers, who are eligible under the FRA.
- c) The each of concerned Gram Sabha(s), has certified that all formalities/ processes under the FRA have been carried out, and that they have given their consent to the proposed diversion and the compensation and ameliorative measures, if any, having understood the purpose and details of proposed diversion. A copy of certificate issued by the gram sabha of Chungru (Forest Village) villages(s) is enclosed as annexure to annexure
- d) The discussion and decisions on such proposals had taken place only when there was a quorum of minimum 50% of the members of Gram Sabha present.
- e) The diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Govt. as required under section 3 (2) of the FRA have been completed and Gram Sabha has been given their consent to it.
- f) The rights of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-Agriculture Communities, where applicable have been specifically safeguarded as per section 3(1) (c) of the FRA.
