Adverting to the subject and reference cited, it is to submit that during the visit of Honourable Chief Minister of Telangana, Hon'ble Minister for IT & Municipal Administration and Hon'ble Minister for R&B to Nalgonda town, it was instructed to construct the permanent helipad for landing of VVIP's in Nalgonda Town in a land of **1.04 Ha** available adjoining to District Collectorate in the open land allocated to Potti Sriramulu Telugu Vishwa Vidyalayam on Miryalaguda Road in Nalgonda Town. But as this site alone is not meeting the standards required for helipad construction, forest land adjoining to the above land which is the only premises available in the Vicinity of Collectorate Complex is selected by the District Authorities for construction of helipad. It is also submitted that DGPS Survey is conducted for the above forest land and survey raw data has been submitted to PCCF and Authentication for the submitted survey data is also received from Principal Chief Conservator of Forests.

The District Collector has requested to take necessary action for diversion of Forest Land and to submit proposals to the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests.

As per the above ref.2nd cited letter, the proposals in (8) sets and undertakings have been prepared and is submitted for taking necessary action for diversion of Forest Land.
