The kilometre stone numbers along roads and canals are shown, in short type, e.g., '9' whereas milestone numbers are shown in upright type e.g., '9'.
Wells are numerous throughout the sheet; only the important ones have been shown.
Cart tracks and unmetalled roads are generally metalled in dry season. Permission to use these along canals is required from the irrigation authorities.
Owing to perennial floods, the courses of the Ganga, Yamuna and Gomti Rivers are continually changing.

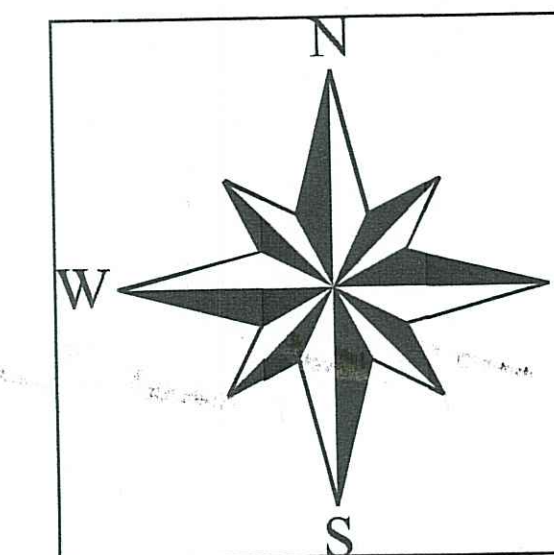

- Diversion of Forest Land

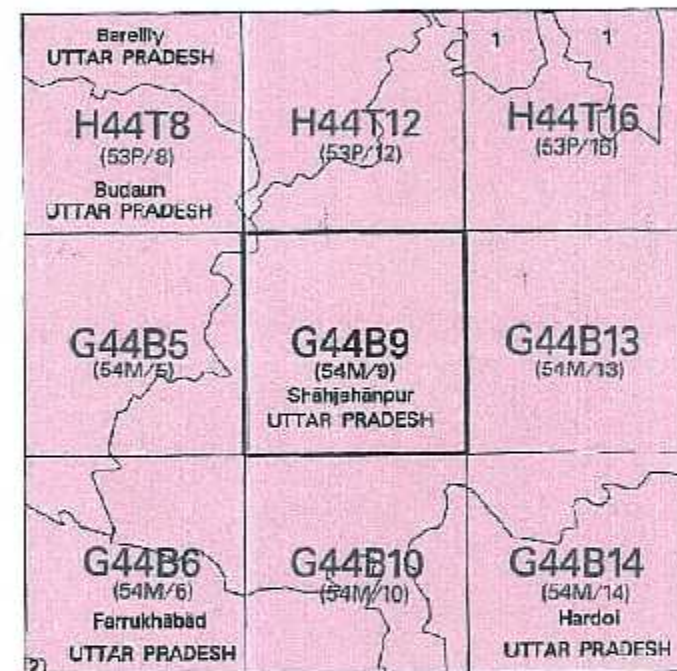
