
Sir,

With reference to the above cited letter on the subject, it is to inform that the Govt. of India MOEF & CC vide their letter No. 8-01/2020-FC dt. 28.07.2021 have accorded in principle approval under section -2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act ,1980 for proposed for diversion of 783.275 ha of forest land in favour of M/S Singareni Collieries Company ltd mining project in Angul District (Odisha). As per Letter No. 26159 dt. 05.12.2018 of Govt. of Odisha, F & E Department, the cost of Regional Wildlife Management Plan of the above project is to be deposited by you as per the calculation given below.

1. Total Mining lease area of the above project = 912.799 ha
(Forest land – 783.275 ha + 129.524 ha NF land)
2. Regional Wildlife Management Plan @ Rs.82000/- per ha.
3. Cost of RWM Plan = 912.799 ha X Rs.82000/- = Rs. 7,48,49,518/-

Hence you are requested to deposit the cost of Regional Wildlife Management Plan of Rs. 7,48,49,518/- (Rupees Seven Crore forty eight lakh forty nine thousand five hundred eighteen)only in Ad-hoc CAMPA in the saving Bank Account No. 520101263743655 , Corporation Bank, Lodhi Complex, Ground Floor, Block No. 11, CGO Complex, Lodi Road New Delhi through “e “ payment immediately and intimate the same to the undersigned for taking further action in the matter.



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

Sub: Revision of cost norm for implementation of Regional Comprehensive Wildlife Management Plan in the mining areas of the State at project cost.

Sir,
I am directed to refer to F&E Department letter No. 22675/F&E dt. 5.12.2016 addressed to you on the subject mentioned above and to say that State Government in F&E Department had last fixed the cost norm of Wildlife Management Plan at Rs. 58,000/- per hectare on ML area basis with prospective effect for proper implementation of the Regional Comprehensive Wildlife Management Plan in the mining lease area of the State.

Meanwhile, the State Government in Labour & ESI Department have revised the minimum wage rate to Rs. 280/- per manday w.e.f 30.10.2018. Keeping in view the upward revision of wage rate of Rs. 280/- per manday, the State Government in Forest & Environment Department have been pleased to revise the cost norm of Wildlife Management Plan from Rs. 58,000/- per hectare to Rs. 82,000/- per hectare on ML area basis with effect from 30.10.2018 for proper implementation of the Regional Comprehensive Wildlife Management Plan in the mining lease area of the State. The Mining lessees of Keonjhar-Bonai region as well as those occurring elsewhere in the State having occurrence of wildlife, are required to deposit the cost as per revised norm fixed above.

Required follow up action in the matter may be taken with appropriate orders to Divisional Forest Officers(T&WL).
