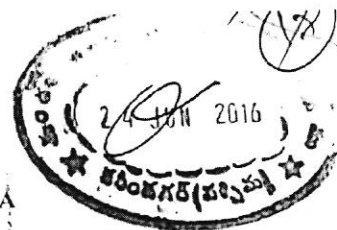

Sub:- Compensatory Afforestation - Karimnagar District - Jagtial Division - Jagtial (M) - Jabithapur (V) - Sy.No.479 - Total extent Ac 191-33 gts - Identified extent of approximately Ac 80-00 gts for afforestation to forest department - Joint inspection of Revenue, R&B and Forest department on 09-06-2016 - DFO (West) categorically accepted for afforestation - report submitted - Request to submit proposals under G.O.Ms.No.571- Reg.

Kind attention is invite to the reference cited, as reported by the Sub-Collector, Jagtial, the Superintending Engineer, (R&B) Circle, Karimnagar has submitted proposal to the Principal Chief Conservator of Forest, Hyderabad that an extent of 112.917 hectares of forest land is required for laying of (10) R&B Road in Karimnagar district and the Principal Chief Conservator of Forest, Hyderabad has accepted for deforestation of the forest land under the condition of compensatory afforestation to an equal extent of non forest land. Further it was requested to send report on availability of Govt. land as per the G.O.MS.No.571, Dt:14-09-2012.

Further stated that, the Tahsildar, Jagtial has submitted an extent of approximately Ac 80-00 gts of land in Sy.No.479 situated at Jabithapur village of Jagtial Mandal is identified which is suitable for compensatory afforestation to forest department.

Further the Sub-Collector, Jagtial has submitted that, on 09-06-2016 he along with Tahsildar Jagtial, Executive Engineer, R&B Jagtial and Divisional Forest Officer (West) have jointly inspected the land in Sy.No.479 situated at Jabithapur village of Jagtial Mandal which is suitable for Compensatory afforestation to forest department and during the inspection the Divisional Forest Officer (West) Karimnagar has categorically accepted that the land is suitable for afforestation, as per sethwar the Sy.No.479 is classified as BR and the total extent of land is Ac 191-33 gts, out of which an extent of Ac 23-13 gts is assigned to weaker section, an extent of Ac 15-00 gts is alienated to different departments and approximately an extent of Ac 80-00 gts is available which is suitable for afforestation to forest department.

In view of the above, while enclosing the location sketch of the identified land to an approximate extent of Ac 80-00 gts in Sy.No.479 situated at Jabithapur village of Jagtial Mandal, the Sub-Collector, Jagtial has requested to address the requisition department to submit the Appendix-XXIX under BSO-24 along with the Annexure - XI as per G.O.Ms.No.571, Rev.(Assn.I) Dept., Dt:14-09-2012 from the Head of the Department for allotting the land.
