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Sanction is accorded to the grant of mining lease for limestone over an area of 44,000 Hect. at Gumar, Bajar War River, Pulwama District, in favour of Sh. Mawar Ahmed of Mawar, District Pulwama R/O Baramulla, Srinagar for a period of 30 years in terms of Mines and Minerals (Regulation and Development) Act, 1957 for establishment of 250 R.P.D. Cement plant on the following terms and conditions:-

1. The lessee shall have no objection to the construction of further investigation in the leased area by the Geology and Mining Department as and when required.
2. The lessee shall take immediate steps to set up 250 R.P.D. Cement plant conforming to the Mining and Geology Department's plan for economic development of the area.
3. The lessee shall abide by the provisions of Mines and Minerals (Regulation and Development) Act, 1957 and Minerals (Conservation) Rules, 1958 framed thereunder.
4. The lessee shall mine only limestone for manufacturing of cement.
5. The lessee shall execute lease deed with the Govt. in accordance with Rule 31 of Mines Act, 1957.
6. The lease shall be effective from the date of completion of the 250 R.P.D. Cement plant.

In partial modification of Government Order No. 103, Ind of 1998 dated 5-3-1998, amendment is accorded to the grant of Mining Lease for Limestone over an area of 44,000 Hect. in favour of Shri Mushaq Ahmed Tremboos S/O Naji about 1000 Hect. in District Pulwama, Srinagar for a period of 30 years in terms of Mining and Minerals (Regulation and Development) Act, 1957 for establishment of 300 T.P.C. cement plant on the following terms and conditions:-

- 1/- The Lessee shall have no objection to the conducting of further investigation in the leased area by the Geology and Mining Department as and when required.
- 2/- The Lessee shall take immediate steps to set up 300 T.P.C. cement plant contiguous to the leased area in order to promote economic development of the said area.
- 3/- The Lessee shall abide by the provisions of the Mines and Minerals (Regulations and Development) Act, 1957 and Minerals Concession Rules, 1960 framed thereunder.
- 4/- The Lessee shall mine only Lime stone for manufacture of cement.
- 5/- That the Lessee shall commence the mining operation including the installation of machinery within a period of one year from the date of execution of the lease deed falling which the Lessee shall stand lapsed, as provided under rule 38 of Mineral Concession Rules, 1960.
