**Sub:-** Diversion of 9.81 ha of forest land in Agsoor & Gundbal villages in Karwar Division for construction of Vented barrage across Gangavali river at Honnalli in favour of AEE, KUWS&DB, Karwar.

Adeverting to the above, the estimate for Construction of Vented barrage across Gangavali river at Honnalli amounting to Rs. 158.62 Crores is approved by GoK vide letter No: NAE/36/UWS/2015, Bangalore Dtd: 10-10-2017. Vented barrage is proposed for a storage capacity of 10,858 MI to cater water demand for 4months during summer period (120 days), considering the water demand upto 2068 for drinking water supply to Karwar, Ankola, enroute villages, Project Seabird & M/s. Aditya Birla Company. The storage hight of the water is proposed as 10.50Mtr.

In the above work totally 47-21-02 acres of revenue land & 9.81 Hectares of Forest land will be submerged when the storage depth crosses the hight of 7.50Mtr.

Regarding acquisition of Forest land of around 9.81 Hectares, proposal has been submitted to the Central Government under Forest Conservation Act,1980 through the online portal of Ministry of Enviornment Forests & Climate change initially on 22-07-2017. On further verification from the Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forest, Bengaluru, they have mentioned shortfalls through E-mail to the application submitted by this office regarding Compensatory Afforestation land.

Accordingly vide DC, Karwar letter No: ಕಂಶಾ/ಅರಣ್ಯ/ವಿವ-20/2016-17 Dtd: 06-10-2017 under ref(4), the details of Compensatory Afforestation land submitted to the Forest Department through online.

Further they have mentioned shortcomings regarding Compensatory Afforestation land & after discussion with DFO, Karwar following documents are essential

- 1) RFOR certificate of the Forest land
- 2) A Map showing Compensatory Afforestation land overlaid on Cadastral (village) map along with the list of GPS readings of the all corners of the land. (Observation L(v) in the ref(2)).
- 3) Toposheet showing the location of Compensatory Afforestation land (Observation L(vi) in the ref(2)).
- 4) Relevant Kml file of the Compensatory Afforestation land (Observation L-(iv)(c) in the ref(2)).

In this regard it is requested to provide the necessary documents for the fulfillment of observations made by Forest Department.
