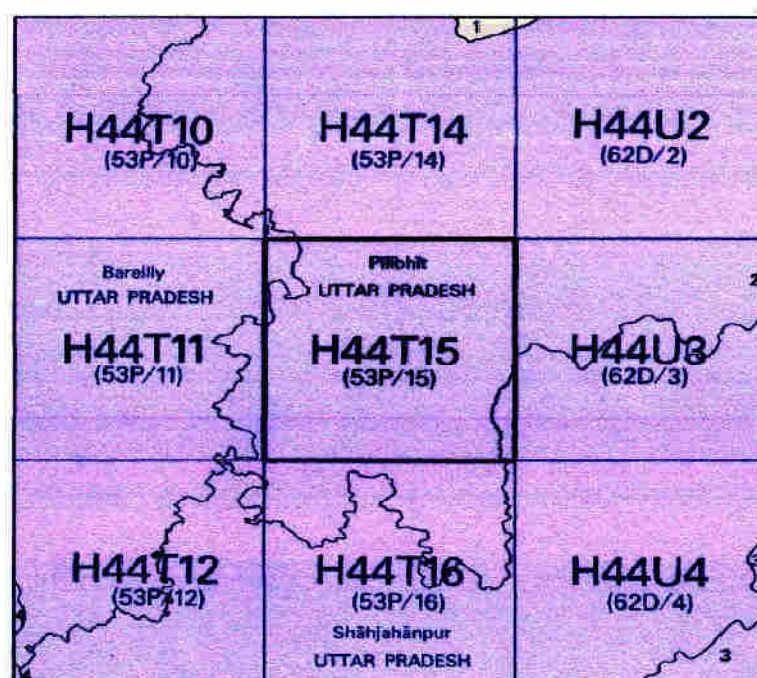

Heights and contours have not been shown.

A relative height, h_r , represents the approximate height, in meters, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.

The kilometre stone numbers along the railway, roads and canals shown in slant type, e.g., 5', whereas milestone numbers are shown in upright type, e.g., 5'.

Towns, shown *dx*, in this area usually contain water from July to October.

Wells and tube-wells are numerous throughout the sheet; only the important ones have been shown.

Owing to periodical floods the course of the Deocha River is continually changing.

Large areas of land, very fertile with period over the Deocha River, are fordable for the remaining part of the year.

Cart-tracks and unmetalled roads in the sheet are generally motorable in dry season. Permission to use roads and cart-tracks along canals and inside forest areas is required from the Irrigation and Forest authorities, respectively.
