Subject: Justification of the Project and feasibility of the Route selected.

Reference: OFC connectivity between Kolagondanahalli (TN border) to Bheemagondahalli.

TNL formerly known as Airtel is building a Fiber Optic Network to address the bandwidth and coverage issues in the rural part of Ramanagara District. This is also the requirement of Central Govt. as a part of digital initiative to connect remote villages in India. To ensure better mobile coverage, towers at strategic locations need to be connected with fiber optic cable, namely at Kolagondanahalli, Gattigunda, Hunasanahalli and Bheemagondahalli.

To connect these towers, three different route options (alignment) were proposed as referred below.

Option A: From Kolagondanahalli via Gattigunda, Hunasanahalli to Bheemagondahalli.

Option B: From Kolagondanahalli via Jawalagiri (TN), Gulvadiilligaradhoddi, Hunasanahalli to Bheemagondahalli.

Option C: From Kolagondanahalli via Jawalagiri (TN) Ulibande, Hunasanahalli to Bheemagondahalli.

We have to build the network through the forest land to connect these mobile towers. Based on our desktop study, physical site survey and information obtained from the local govt. agencies, **no other alternate non-forest roads are available in this locality.**


We have finalized **Option A** due to the following reasons:

1. *Minimal exposure in the forest land*
2. *Shortest route length*

We are discarding Option B and Option C as the usage of forest-land is very much higher than Option A.
