5. The proposals shall be examined under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 as per the guidelines issued by Ministry of Environment & Forests vide Letter No.11-9/1998-FC (Pt) dated.5-7-2013 and requisite certificates /documents be furnished.
6. Other conditions specified in the GOI,MoEF, letters dated.03.01.2005,13.05.2011,16.6.2011,13.02.214 and 07.11.2014 shall also be completed with by Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, Telangana State, Hyderabad and user agency with which they are concerned.
7. The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the proposals.
8. The forest land to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agency, department or person without prior approval of the Government.
9. The User Agency shall be responsible for any loss to the flora/fauna in the surroundings.
10. Any tree felling shall be done only when it is unavoidable and that too under strict supervision of the Forest Department.
11. The total forest area utilized for the project shall not exceed 1.947 ha. In case the land is not taken over by the User Agency or the same is not used for the stipulated purpose within a period of two years, then the area shall be taken back by the Forest Department.
12. The Forest Department may impose time to time any other conditions(s) in the interest of conservation, protection and / or development of forests.
13. The User Agency shall put two permanent boards at the entrance and exit points of the Reserve Forests in the said locations about the status of the land.
14. Publish the entire forest clearances granted in verbatim along with the condition and safe-guards imposed by the Central government in two widely circulated daily news paper one is vernacular language and the other in English granted to the project proponent for the use of forest land for the non-forest purposes.
15. The copies of the forest clearance should also be submitted to the heads of local bodies, Panchayats and municipal bodies by the project proponents in

- addition to the relevant offices of the Government who in turn has to display the same for 30 days from the date of receipt of this reference.
16. The muck generated in the earth cutting if any, shall be disposed off at designated dumping sites and in no case the muck/debris will be disposed off in the forest areas.
 17. Wherever necessary, user agency shall provide free supply of water for forest nurseries and field staff quarters and range offices, besides providing outlets with small troughs during summer for wild animals in forest areas.
 18. The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without prior approval of the Central Government.
 19. The user agency shall use existing paths and roads for laying of pipeline and no new paths/ roads are to be formed.
 20. Minimum disturbance should be ensured by creating labour camps outside the forest area as far as possible and it will be the responsibility of the UA to ensure that the labourers & staff engaged in execution of work do not destruct nearby forest flora & fauna.
 21. The user agency should make provisions for supply of water to wildlife at designated places/ along the route passing through forest areas, in consultation with Telangana Forest Department. Such provision should be made at intervals of 2km each. The Chief Wildlife Warden is advised to develop a master plan to use the proposed pipelines for supply of water to the wildlife. Precautions have to be taken to avoid concentration of livestock at the water point.
 22. Any other conditions that the Central Government or Addl. PCCF(Central) of Regional Office, Chennai may impose from time to time in the interest of afforestation, conservation and management of flora and fauna in the area, shall be complied by the user agency.
 23. In the event of failure to comply with any of the above conditions, the user agency is liable for penal action as decided by the Additional PCCF (Central), Regional Office, Chennai.
 24. The User Agency shall deposit an amount of **Rs.21,43,000 (Rupees Twenty One lakhs Forty Three thousand Only,** Construction of Boundary Pillars & Tree growth Extraction and transportation etc., (the details are shown in the below table), through online in the SB A/c. bearing No. **62491766369**, IFSC Code: **SBIN0020112** of State Bank of India, Banswada Branch, Banswada in the name of **Forest Divisional Officer, Banswada** .





In continuation of this office vide reference 3rd cited, It is to inform that Government of India, Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate change, Regional Office (South Eastern Zone), Chennai vide reference 1st cited has accorded in-principle (Stage-I) approval for diversion of 4.115 Ha Forest Land (1.9478 Ha in Banswada Division + 2.168 Ha in Nizamabad) Forest Divisions of Forest land for laying of pipe line and construction of structures in Segment-12/3 (Banswada), for providing safe drinking water in Nizamabad Districts under Telangana Drinking Water supply project in favour of Superintending Engineer, TDWSP Circle, Nirmal, subject to the compliance of the certain conditions mentioned therein.

As per the conditions stipulated, the User Agency has to make the payment towards the following compensatory levels:

As communicated in reference 2nd cited, if the User Agency makes payment of CA/NPV amounts after 15th October 2015, the payment has to be made in e-portal of forest clearances of MoEF, GOI, New Delhi in consultation with Nodal Officer, Telangana State Forest Department.

Further, the user agency is requested to comply with the following in accordance with the GoI instructions issued vide F. No. 7-23/2012-FC, dt. 24.07.2013 communicated vide P.C.C.F, A.P, Hyderabad Rc.No. 45921/2001-F4, dt. 23.08.2013, at the cost of the Project proponent:

- 1) Publish the entire forest clearances granted in verbatim along with the conditions and safe guard imposed by the Central Government in two widely circulated daily newspapers one in vernacular language and the other in English language so as to make people aware of the permission granted to the project proponent for use of forest land for non-forest purposes.
- 2) The copies of the Forest Clearance should also be submitted to the Heads of local bodies, Panchayats and Municipal Bodies by the project proponents in addition to the relevant offices of the Government who in turn has to display the same for 30 days.

Further the Superintending Engineer, TDWSP (RWS&S) Circle, Nirmal is also informed that, the NPV of the diverted forest land, if any, becoming due after finalization of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India on receipt of the report from the expert committee shall be charged by the State Government from the User Agency. The User Agency shall furnish an undertaking to this effect. The following conditions stipulated in Stage-I approval shall be complied with and condition-wise compliance report shall be furnished:

1. The legal status of the forest land shall remain unchanged.
2. The demarcation of the proposed forest area shall be carried out by erecting 4 feet height cement concrete pillars duly numbered at an interval of 20 meters at the cost of User Agency before stage II approval.
3. The Compensatory Afforestation (CA) shall be raised and maintained by the State Forest Department over 1.036 ha out of the 145.18 Ha of non- forest land identified in Sy.No. 100 of Nagilla Village at Mudgul Mandal in Amangal Range of Amangal Division at the cost of User Agency.
4. Identified CA land and approved CA Scheme shall not be changed without the prior approval of the Central Government.
5. The CA area identified at Amangal Division which is apportioned project wise shall be treated as per the CA scheme approved.
6. Non-forest land identified for raising Compensatory Afforestation shall be transferred and mutated in favour of the State Forest Department before issue of the stage -II clearance.
7. Non- forest which is transferred and mutated in favour of the state Forest Department for purpose of Compensatory Afforestation, shall be declared as Reserved Forest under Section-4 or protected Forest under Section-29 of the Indian Forest Act 1927 or under the relevant section (S) of the local Forest Act. The Nodal Officer must report compliance within a period of 6 months from the date of grant of final approval and

8. The state Government shall charge the Net Present Value of the diverted forest land measuring of 4.115 Ha Forest Land (1.9478 Ha in Banswada Division + 2.168 Ha in Nizamabad) from user agency as per the orders of the Hon'bles Supreme Court dated: 28.03.2008 and 09.05.2008 in IA Nos.826 in 566 with related IA's in write petition (Civil) No.202/1995.

Additional amount of Net Present Value (NPV) of the diverted forest land if any, becoming due after revision of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in future, shall be charged by the State Government from the User Agency. User Agency shall furnish an undertaking to this effect, shall be paid by the user agency and deposited either in SB A/c No.37100101029963 of Corporation Bank, CGO Complex, Lodhi Road, New Delhi -110003 (RTGS/IFSC No.CORP0000371) or SB A/c No.344902010106351 of union Bank of India, Sunder Nagar, New Delhi -110003 (RTGS/IFSC No.UBINO534498).

The User Agency shall deposit an amount of **Rs. 82.06 lakhs (Eighty Five lakhs Six Thousand only)** towards Extraction and transportation of tree growth and Construction of Boundary Pillars, in the SB A/c. bearing No. **074910100173844 (FDO, Nizamabad)**, IFSC Code: **ANDB0000749** of Andhra Bank, Badabazar, Nizamabad.

9. The funds received from the User Agency towards Compensatory Afforestation and Net Present Value under this project including levies towards mitigation measures for wildlife conservation etc shall be deposited in the respective bank account of the Telangana State CAMPA. **The User Agency shall compulsorily deposit the NPV and other levies, only by generating challan through the Ministry's website.**
10. The muck generated in the earth if any, shall be disposed off at designated dumping sites and in no case the muck/debris will be disposed off in the forest areas.
11. Tree felling in the proposed forest area shall be carried out wherever necessary, with the prior permission of the Forest Divisional Officer concerned.
12. State Forest Department shall carry out translocation of the trees wherever feasible at the cost of User Agency.
13. Wherever necessary, user agency shall provide free supply of water for forest nurseries and field staff quarters and range offices, besides providing outlets with small troughs during summer for wild animals in forest areas.
14. The Forest land proposed for diversion shall under no circumstances be transferred or sublet to any other agency, department or person without prior approval of the Central Government.
15. The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without the prior approval of the Central Government. User Agency shall furnish an undertaking to this effect.
16. The User Agency shall use existing paths and roads for laying of pipeline and no new paths/roads are to be formed.
17. As recommended by the Forest Divisional Officer, Nizamabad, the User Agency shall erect two permanent boards at the entrance and exit points of the forest area proposed for diversion about status of the land.

18. Minimal disturbance should be ensured by creating labour camps outside the forest area as far as possible and it will be the responsibility of the user agency to ensure that the labourers & staff engaged in execution of work do not destruct near by forest flora & fauna.
19. The total forest area utilized for the project shall not exceed 4.115 ha and the forest area diverted shall not be used for any purpose other than those shown in the diversion proposal.
20. The User Agency should make provisions for supply of water to wildlife at designated places /along the route passing through forest areas, in consultation with Telangana Forest department. Such provision should be made at intervals of 2 km each. The Chief Wild life Warden is advised to develop a master plan to use the proposed pipelines for supply of water to the wildlife. Precautions have to be taken to avoid concentration of livestock at the water point.
21. The progress of the Compensatory Afforestation as mentioned by the Forest Divisional Officer, Nizamabad in SLNo. 12(V)(a) of part II i.e 22 ha of forest land shall be monitored by the Circle Head and a copy of such monitoring report shall be forwarded to regional Office to upload the same in the web portal.
22. The user agency and State Government shall ensure compliance to provisions of the all Acts, Rules, regulations and Guidelines, for the time being in force as applicable to the project.
23. Any other conditions that the Central Government or Addl. PCCF (Central) of Regional Office, Chennai may impose from time to time in the interest of afforestation, Conservation and management of flora and fauna in the area, shall be complied by the User Agency.
24. In the event of failure to comply with any of the above conditions the user agency is liable for penal action as decided by the Additional Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests (Central), Regional Office, Chennai.

After receipt of the compliance on the above mentioned conditions the proposals will be considered for final approval. Transfer of Forest Land to the User Agency shall not be affected prior to the issue of final approval. This in-principle approval shall be valid for a period of 5 years. In the event of non compliance of the above conditions, this in-principle approval shall automatically stand revoked after (5) years.
