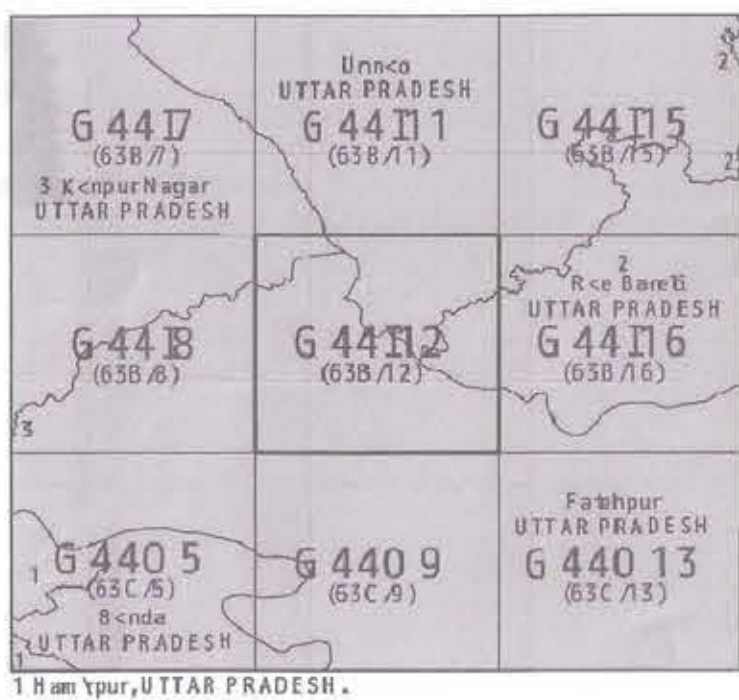

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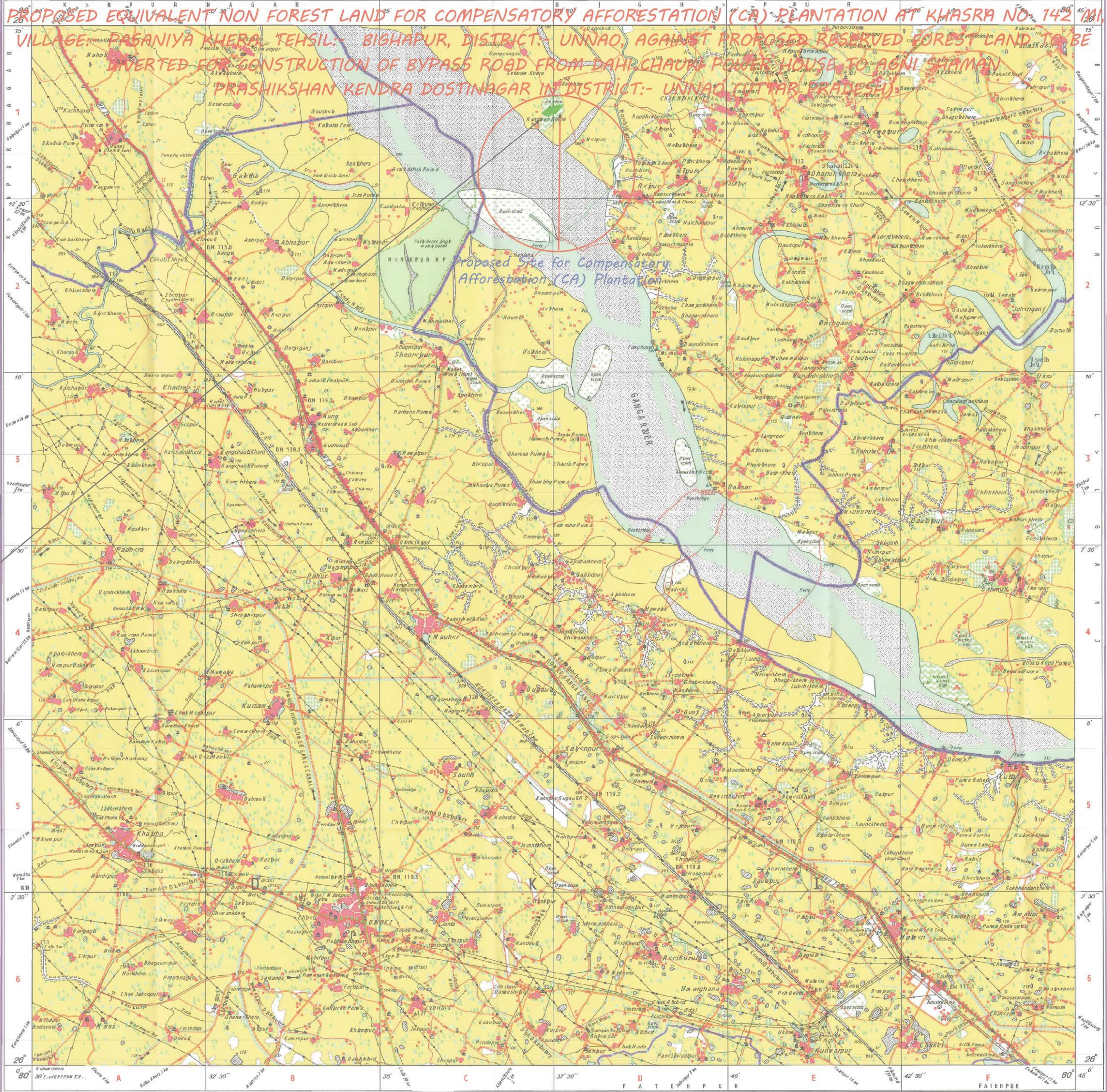
CONVENTIONAL SYMBOLS

- Express highway with toll, with bridge, with distance stone
Roads, metalled: according to importance
Roads, double carriageway according to importance
Unmetalled road. Cart-track. Foot-track with pass. Foot-path
Streams: with track in bed, unfilled. Canal
Dams: masonry or rock-filled, earthenwork
River: dry with water channel, with island & rocks. Tidal river
Submerged rocks. Shoal. Swamp. Heeds
Wells: lined, unfilled. Tube-well. Spring. Tanks: perennial, dry
Embankment: road or rail, tank, broken ground
Railways: broad gauge: double: single with station, under construction
Railways, other gauges: double: single with distance stone, etc.
Mineral line or tramway. Kin. Cuffine with tunnel
Coffins with sub-features. Rocky slopes. Cliffs
Sand features: (1) flat. (2) sand-hills (permanent). (3) dunes (shifting)
Towns or Villages: inhabited, deserted. Fort
Huts: permanent, temporary. Tower. Antiquities
Temple, Chhatra, Church, Mosque, Idgah, Tomb, Gumbaz
Lighthouse. Lightship. Buoy: lighted, unlighted. Anchorage
Mine. Vine on trellis. Grass. Scrub
Palms palm-trees, other. Plantain. Conifer. Bamboo. Other trees
Acre: cultivated, wooded, surveyed
Boundary: international
state: demarcated, undemarcated
district: subdivision, taluk or tahsil, forest
Boundary pillars: surveyed, unlocated
Heights: triangulated, station, spot, approximate
Bench mark: geodetic, tertiary, usual
Post office, Telegraph office, Overhead tank
Rest house or inspection bungalow. Circular house. Public station
Camping ground. Forest: reserved, protected
Spaced names: administrative, locality or place
Hospital, Dispensary, Veterinary Hospital, Dispensary
Aerodrome. Helipad. Turret site
Power line: with pylons surveyed, with poles unsurveyed

NOTES
Heights are in metres and above Indian mean sea level
Contours are approximate
A relative height, e.g., 50, represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope
The kilometre stone numbers along roads, railways and canals are shown in small type, e.g., 10 where the kilometre number is shown in small type, e.g., 10
Cart-roads and unmetalled roads in this sheet are generally unsuitable in dry season. Permission to use those along canals is required from the irrigation authorities
The area adjoining the Ganga River is liable to change owing to continual fluctuation in the course of the river
Fences on the Ganga River only take pedestrian traffic throughout the year
Tanks, shown dry in this area, usually contain water from July to March
Webs are numerous throughout the sheet, only the important ones have been shown
The dotted boundary, where following the main deep water channel of the Ganga River will change with the fluctuations of that channel
