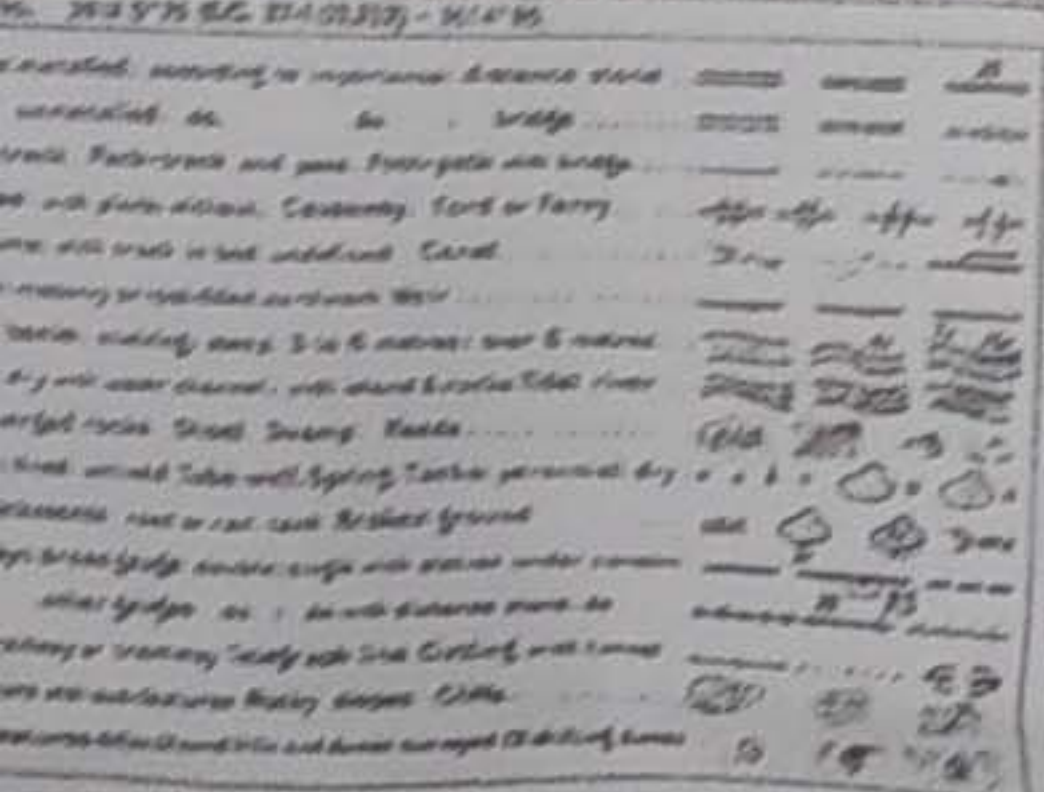


Summers 1963-64, 1967-70

A relative height, e.g., 40, marked along a road, indicates the height of the top of the road embankment above the adjacent country.
