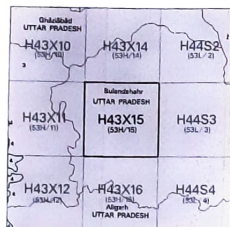

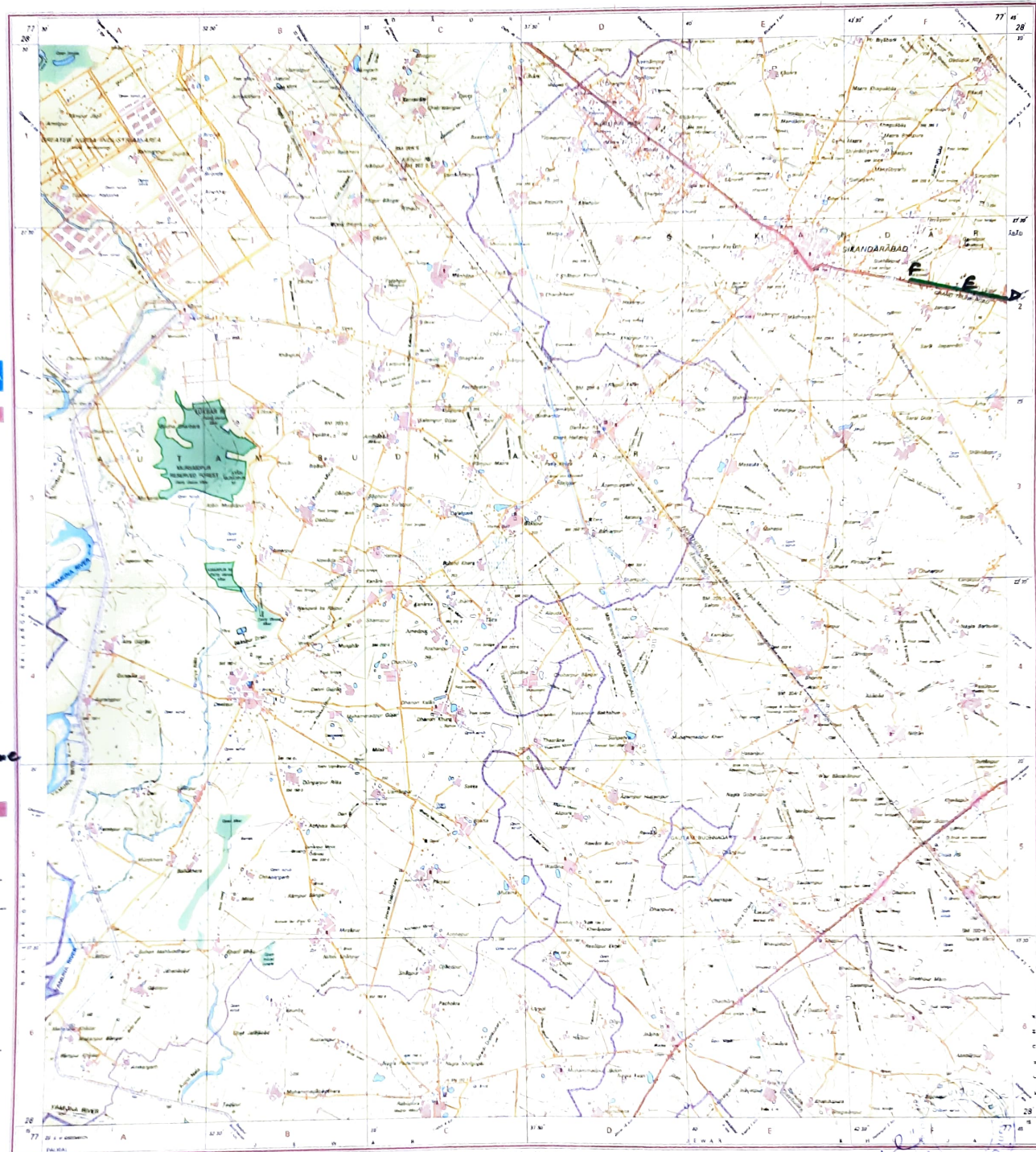
FIGURE 10. *Median survival time, by age group, for patients with stage I disease.*
