117:- Application presented on 15.7.84 by Shri. Dharamchand Jain for grant of Mining Lease for Iron Ore over an area of 251.00 acres in village-Dulpada in the district of Keonjhar.

Order:-

Whereas Sh. Dharamchand Jain has applied to the State Government for grant of a Mining Lease by his application read above;

Whereas the mineral in the land in respect of which the mining lease has been applied for belongs to Government and the land is at its disposal;

Whereas the applicant holds a valid Certificate of Approval from the State Government;

Whereas the applicant being an individual is a citizen of India;

Whereas the applicant by himself or with any person joint or in interest with him does not in respect of such ore mineralized areas of minerals hold such area in the State as in the area over which the mining lease has now been asked for will exceed ten square kms. in the aggregate;

Whereas the Government of India in their letter No. 5(55)/82-Mt. 2.2.83 have conveyed their approval to the grant of Mining Lease under Section 5(3) of the Mines and Minerals (Regulation and Development) Act, 1957 and also in exercise of the powers conferred by section 3) of the said act, directed the State Government to take into consideration this application and pass orders thereon;

Whereas the party was asked in Mining Department letter No. 5143/Mt dated 2.3.84 to accept the terms and conditions under which the Mining Lease was proposed to be considered for grant and the party in his letter with no. 111 dated 5.3.84 accepted these conditions;

Therefore, the State Government hereby pleased to order that Mining Lease in respect of the land over 251.00 acres be granted to Sh. Dharamchand Jain for 20 (twenty) years subject to the conditions laid down in the State Govt. letter No. 5143/Mt dated 2.3.84. The party should comply with all the terms and conditions including furnishing of a surveyed map and description within 3 months from the date of this order to the Collector, Keonjhar.

aggregating to 259.95 acres situated at the place of Jagaduli danda and danda
subject to the provisions of the Mines and Minerals (Regulation and Development)
Act, 1957 and Mineral Concession Rules, 1960 and all in accordance with the compliance of all
the required formalities before execution of the mining lease. After execution
four copies each of the executed deeds may be sent to Government and one copy
each of the lease deeds to Director of Mining and Geology, Orissa.

Order :

Whereas M/s. Dharamchand Jain has executed a mining lease No. 5/6.86 for Iron ore over an area of 101.271 hectares in village Dalpanar of Keonjhar district for a period of 20 (Twenty) years

Whereas the lessee in his letter No. DCJ (ML) - 100/SM/93 dated 13.3.93 reported occurrence of Manganese ore and requested the State Government to allow inclusion of the said mineral in the existing lease hold of Iron ore as required under Clause 9 of Part-VII of lease deed and Rule 27(1)(b) of M.C.
