REASON:

Whereas M/s. Unaramchand Jain has executed a mining lease on 5.6.86 for iron ore over an area of 101.271 hecta. in village Dalsahar of Keonjhar district for a period of twenty years

whereas the lessee in his letter No. DCJ(ML-ALP(SM)/93 dat 13.3.93 reported occurrence of Manganese ore and requested the State Government to allow inclusion of the said mineral in the existing lease hold of iron ore as required under Clause 9 of Part-VII of lease deed and Rule 27(1)(b) of M.C. Rules, 1960.
