

Justification for Locating the Project in Forest Area

DMRC is extending the Mass Rapid Transit System (MRTS) project from Mundka to Bahadurgarh as a deposit work of Government of Haryana as per Agreement signed by the Government of Haryana and DMRC on 02.02.2013.

In order to feed power supply to Mundka-Bahadurgarh metro corridor, DMRC is constructing a 132 kV Receiving Sub-station (RSS) which will take power supply through two nos. of 132 kV cable underground feeders from Nuna Majra substation of HVPNL, the approximate distance between these two places is 11 Km.

The cable will be laid either in trenches or through trenchless method. The trench will be 1.8 m deep and 1.1 m wide. On all roads crossings and at other specific locations, cable laying shall be through trenchless drilling and the cable shall be passed through HDPE pipe of appropriate diameter and thickness. The feeder cables will pass through some area which belongs to forests department. Therefore, permission from forest department is required so that cable can be through their area.
