

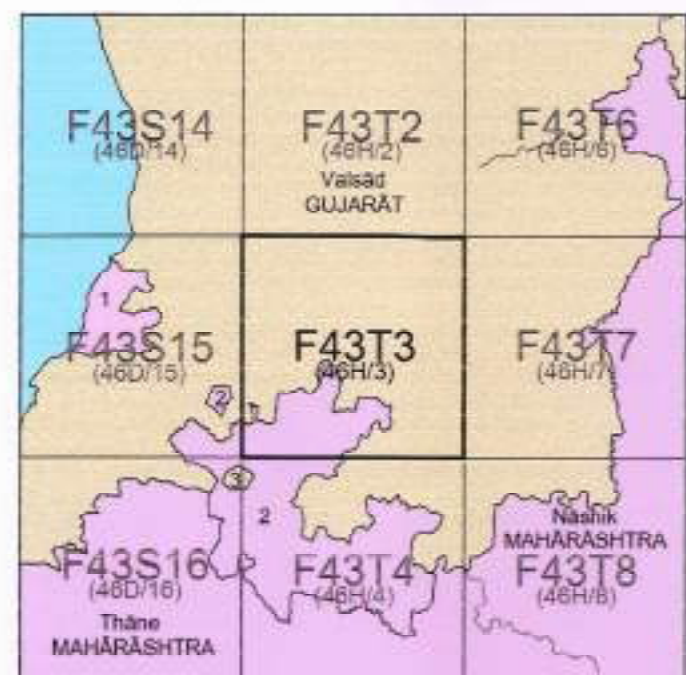

A relative height, e.g., 2, represents the approximate height, in metres, between top and bottom of a steep slope.

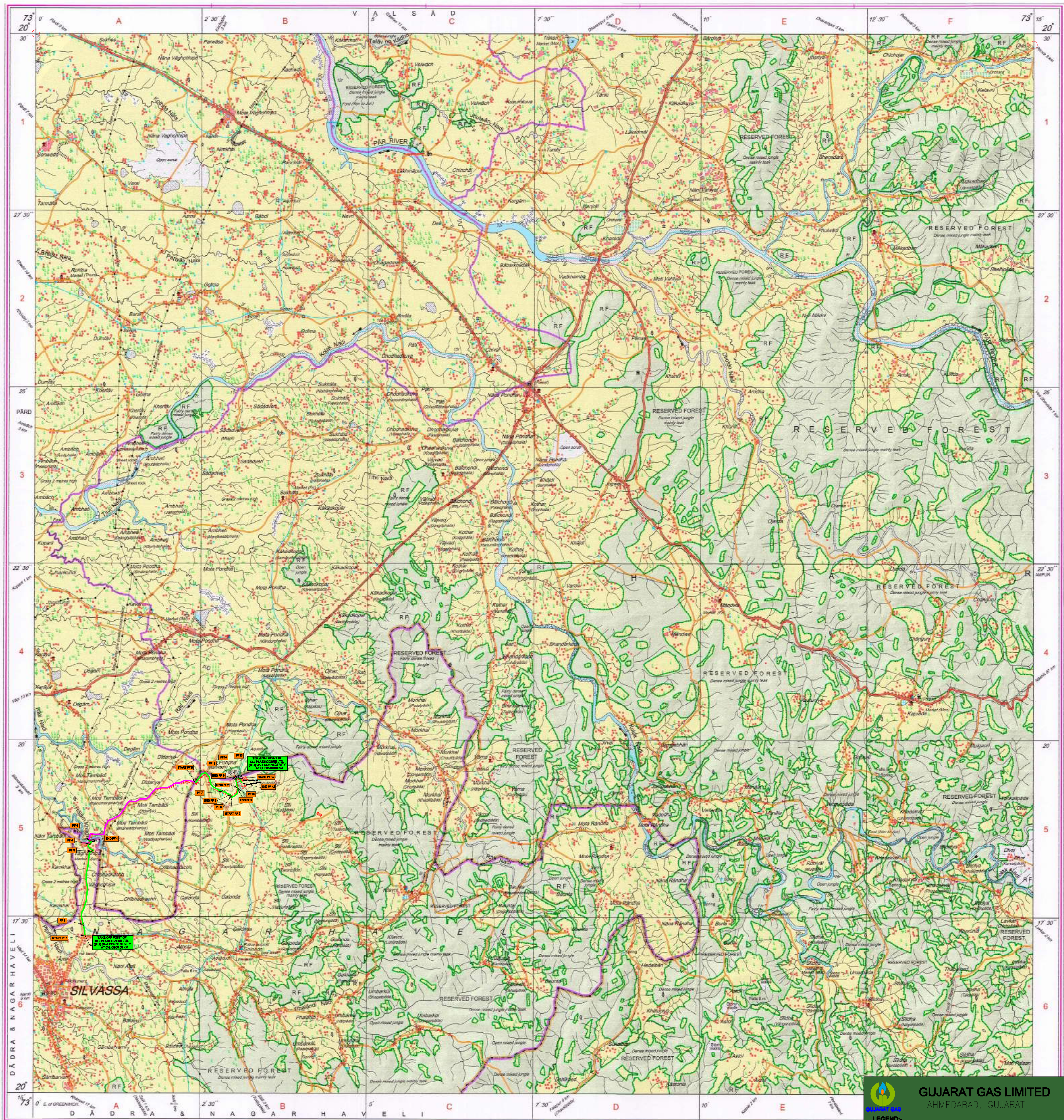
