The writings should be white colour and pillar to be pained bi-coulour of red and green. Photographs showing permanent boundary pillars with GPS co-ordinates be submitted after completion of the works. Necessary fund as estimated by you vide your letter No.SK/120/17-18/527 dated 13.02.2018 will make advance as soon as receipt of the amount from the user agency, Sri Debesh Ch. Roy.
