NOTES

- Tanks shown dry, in this area usually contain water from July to December.
- Tube-wells are numerous throughout the sheet, only the important ones have been shown.
- Distance stones along Bathinda-Bathinda (Bathinda-CANAL) are 5000 feet apart and every casting one is shown.
- A metric height, H, represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.
- Permission to use cart-tracks and unmetalled road along canal is required from the irrigation authorities.
- The administrative boundaries and names have been brought up to date to 2007.

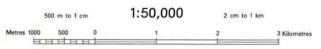

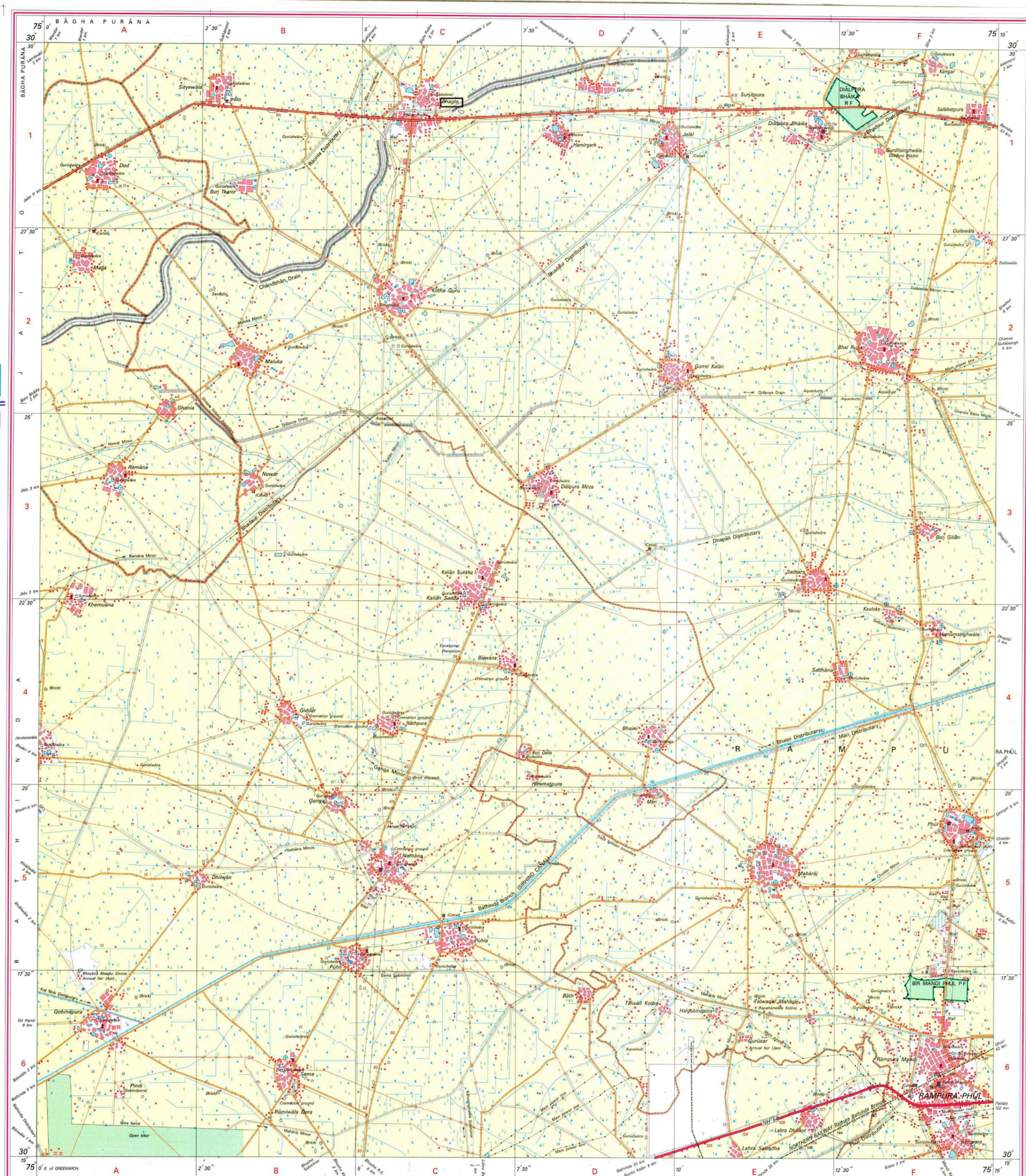
