## To Construct Building Asst. Regional Transport Office Honnavar (U.k)

ARTO is called Asst. Regional Transport Office. It is a purely **Karnataka state Government Organization**. The primary motive is to maintain database of all the vehicles of the state as wall as different state and union territories of India.

ARTO office is executive the activities and function as per the motor vehicle act 1988 and rules made there under and Transport Commissioner is the head of the department in the state.

The aim is to ensure proper functioning of the vehicles which are allotted under specific series in the state. The Regional Transport Office collecting the tax from the vehicle which are not paid taxes. The rules is also involves in identifying the all class of vehicles in the state.

The responsibility of ARTO office is to Registration of the all class of vehicles and re-registration, transfer of ownership, issuing of the driving licences, collection of Taxes form the motor vehicles, issuing and grants of fitness certificate to transport vehicles and also check validity of the insurances polices, we need to establish infrastructure like computerization and room for learner licence test, biometric test, than collecting computerized fees in the treasury section.

Every day about 300pepoles visit to get there different work in this office. This is very necessary to provide minimum amenities to publics.

Our office revenue target is 2928 crocs. At present we are working in rented building. We need land to conduct driving licence test in the prescribed driving track and parking place for motor vehicles to registered new vehicles and track to conducted fitness certificate for transport vehicles. Hence we proposed grant forest land of 0.90 hectare (2.10 Acer) Ramathirth Road, Honnavar Taluk, Uttar Kannada District.
